

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARINGS

SALT LAKE COUNTY AND MOUNTAINOUS PLANNING DISTRICT PLANNING COMMISSIONS

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN Pursuant to Utah Code Title 17, Chapter 79, Section 205, that the Salt Lake County Planning Commission (the “Commission”) will hold a public hearing on Wednesday, March 11, 2026 at 8:30 AM, and the Mountainous Planning District Planning Commission will hold a public hearing on Thursday March 19, 2026 at 3:00 PM. The purpose of these hearings is to receive public comment regarding a proposed land use ordinance:

OAM2026-001589 - An ordinance amending section 19.72.110, entitled “Tree and Vegetation Protection” and enacting section 19.72.115, entitled “Forest Management Plan, Fuels Reduction Plan” of the Salt Lake Code Of Ordinances, 2001, to provide greater clarity on the standards and processes for approving and implementing these plans; and making other related changes.

The Planning Commissions will act on the proposed ordinance amendment after taking comments from the public during their respective public hearings. Public comments will be provided pursuant to the planning commissions’ rules of conduct. Public comments will be limited to three minutes per person.
