Since November I have been trying to work with the Utah Department of Agriculture (UDAF) to renew my pesticide applicators license. They have created a new system for our CEU/testing program, and it's been a slow rollout. Finally last week I was able to get my profile approved and then after some last-minute study sessions to make sure I would pass the three required tests, I took and passed all three. Normally I could just submit CEU's we can earn from attending meetings and classes during the 3-year license term, but with UDAF's new system I decided I needed to simply take the tests and be done.

I also took in our Ford to get a new windshield; it had a large crack on the driver-side from a large rock last summer and I've been waiting for the new year to get it replaced. While there I purchased new tires for the truck and had its oil changed.
