RESOLUTION 2026-01

**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF LAKETOWN, UTAH
SUPPORTING AN APPLICATION FOR FISCAL YEAR 2027
COMMUNITY PROJECT FUNDING (CPF) FOR THE DRILLING OF A
SECOND DOMESTIC WATER SOURCE**

WHEREAS, Laketown is a municipal corporation and public water supplier duly organized and existing under the laws of the State of Utah; and

WHEREAS, Laketown currently operates the Laketown City Water System, a community water system that served approximately 166 connections at the end of 2025; and

WHEREAS, Utah Administrative Code R309-515-4(3), Number of Sources and Quantity Requirements, requires community water systems serving more than one hundred (100) connections to have a minimum of two (2) sources, except where served by a surface water treatment plant, and requires for each system, the total developed source capacity shall equal or exceed the peak day demand of the system; and

WHEREAS, Laketown currently relies on Laketown Spring as the single domestic water source, leaving the community vulnerable to catastrophic system failure, contamination, or mechanical breakdown; and

WHEREAS, the United State House of Representatives allows for Community Project Funding (CPF) requests for Fiscal Year 2027 to support critical local infrastructure and water initiatives; and

WHEREAS, the proposed project will involve the drilling, testing, and equipping of a second domestic well to bring Laketown into full compliance with state statutory and administrative requirements such as Utah Administrative Code R309-515-4(3); and

WHEREAS, the Town Council is in support of aligning the proposed project with the State's Water Policy, §73-1-21 of Utah State Code (as amended), which requires the pursuit of adequate, reliable, sustainable, and clean water resources for the citizens of Utah; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council is in support of identifying the necessary matching funds or a plan to secure such funds as required by Community Project Funding (CPF) guidelines.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Town Council of Laketown, Utah, as follows:

1. **Support For Application.** The Town Council hereby officially supports the submission of an application for FY27 Community Project Funding and certifies that no elected officials have a financial interest in the project.
2. **Project Necessity.** The Town Council finds that the drilling of a second domestic water source as an essential public safety requirement to comply with Utah Administrative Code R309-515-4(3) and deems it is necessary to ensure a continuous supply of safe drinking water for the Town's residents.

3. **Authorization.** The Mayor is hereby authorized to execute all necessary documents, including financial disclosures and certifications, to advance this funding application request.
