

**RESOLUTION NO. 2026-01**

**A RESOLUTION OF KAMAS CITY, ACKNOWLEDGING AND ACCEPTING THE SR-32 CORRIDOR AND CITY CENTER PLAN AND DIRECTING THAT ITS FINDINGS AND RECOMMENDATIONS BE CONSIDERED IN FUTURE UPDATES TO THE GENERAL PLAN, TRANSPORTATION MASTER PLAN, DEVELOPMENT CODES, AND OTHER GUIDING POLICIES**

**WHEREAS**, the Kamas City Council is authorized under Utah law to prepare and amend a General Plan to guide the City's present and future growth and development;

**WHEREAS**, Kamas City participated in the SR-32 Corridor and City Center Plan project to establish a community vision and policy framework addressing land use, transportation, economic development, public realm improvements, and community character within the SR-32 Corridor and City Center areas;

**WHEREAS**, the project was undertaken in partnership with regional and state agencies and supported in part through funding from the MAG Technical Assistance for Governments (TAG) and UDOT Technical Planning Assistance (TPA) programs, reflecting an interagency commitment to coordinated transportation and land use planning;

**WHEREAS**, the process included stakeholder and community outreach, public meetings, and opportunities for community input to ensure that the Plan reflects local values and priorities;

**WHEREAS**, the SR-32 Corridor and City Center Plan identifies findings, recommendations, goals, and implementation strategies intended to guide future land use decisions, transportation planning, development standards, economic vitality efforts, and public investment within the Plan area;

**WHEREAS**, the City Council has reviewed the Plan and finds that selected goals, policies, and strategies provide helpful guidance for future planning decisions as part of the General Plan update.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council of Kamas City, Utah, as follows:

1. The City Council hereby acknowledges and accepts the results of the SR-32 Corridor and City Center Plan as a guiding policy resource to inform and support the upcoming update to the Kamas City General Plan.
2. The City Council directs that the findings and recommendations contained therein be considered during future updates to the Kamas City General Plan, Transportation Master Plan, development codes, and other guiding policies.

3. The SR-32 Corridor and City Center Plan may be used by the City Council, Planning Commission, and City staff as policy guidance in evaluating land use decisions and planning efforts within the Plan area.
4. This Resolution does not amend the existing General Plan, Transportation Master Plan, development regulations, but provides policy direction for their future review and potential update.
