- **Item No. 2 City Code Title 11: Subdivision Regulations & PCC 7-3-4: Standards Public Hearing:** The Planning Commission will take comments and questions from the public regarding proposed amendments to Providence City Code Title 11: Subdivision Regulations; and removing City Code 7-3-4: Standards. These proposed amendments are to align with the newly adopted Utah American Public Works Association standards and specifications. These amendments simplify and remove double references.
