1. Opening Ceremony, Pledge of Allegiance and Introduction of Guests

2. Approval of Agenda

3. Resolution 02-12-26 - consideration of land purchase for future city hall development

Mr. Green, principal of Fielding Elementary, was in attendance to speak about parking at the school. This year seems to have more cars, the parking is very congested. More and more kids are coming every year which means more parents parking. When the school was originally planned there was consideration for parking but it has exceeded that. Denise Anger was also in attendance for speaking about parking. Mr. Green asked how can we partner with the town and come up with some ideas? He has an idea for next year about parking spaces on the north side of the school. Mayor's concerned about the school adding more classrooms in the future and how that will also affect parking, which there will be 2 more next year. Denise asked if they can encourage the parents to let kids ride the bus instead of picking up? They can be, but there are lots of circumstances of why parents pick up. There was discussion of where extra parking could be on 100 North or Center Street. Would parents be crossing guards? Council cannot vote anything until they see a plan. Center Street and 100 North could be used for parking. School Board engineers need to look at it and bring a plan.
