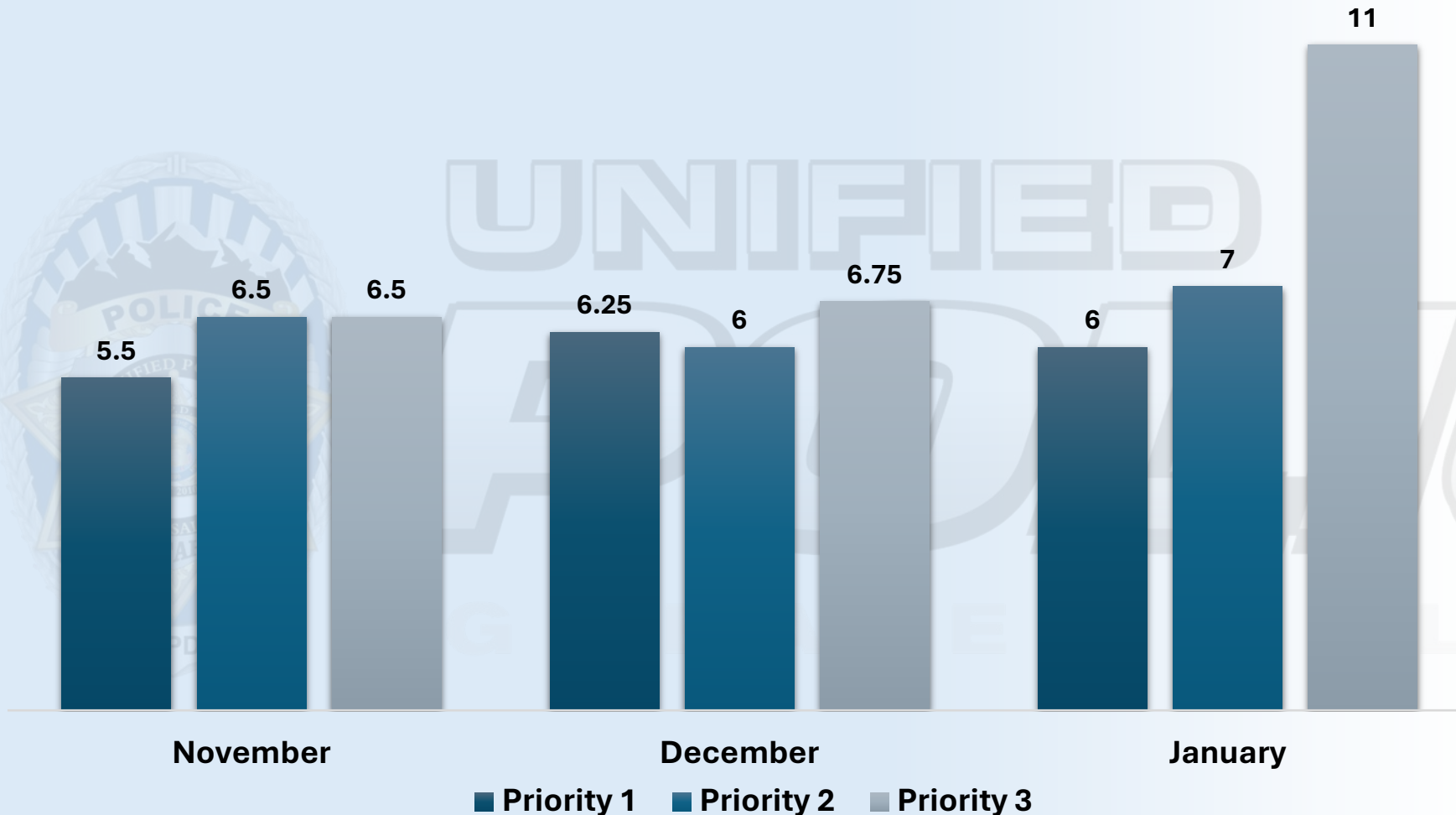

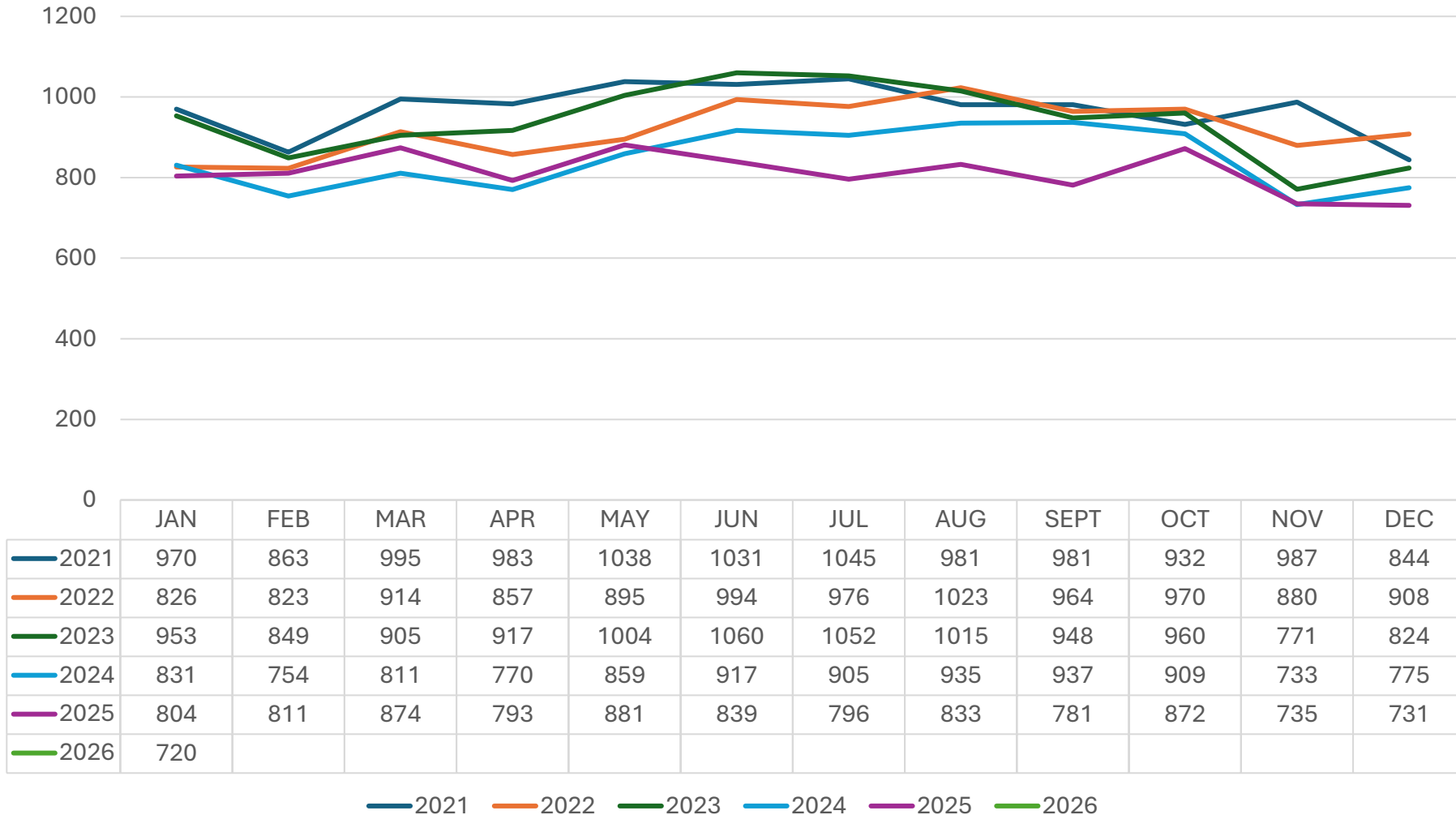
- **Priority 1 (Emergency)**

Millcreek Precinct Case Trend

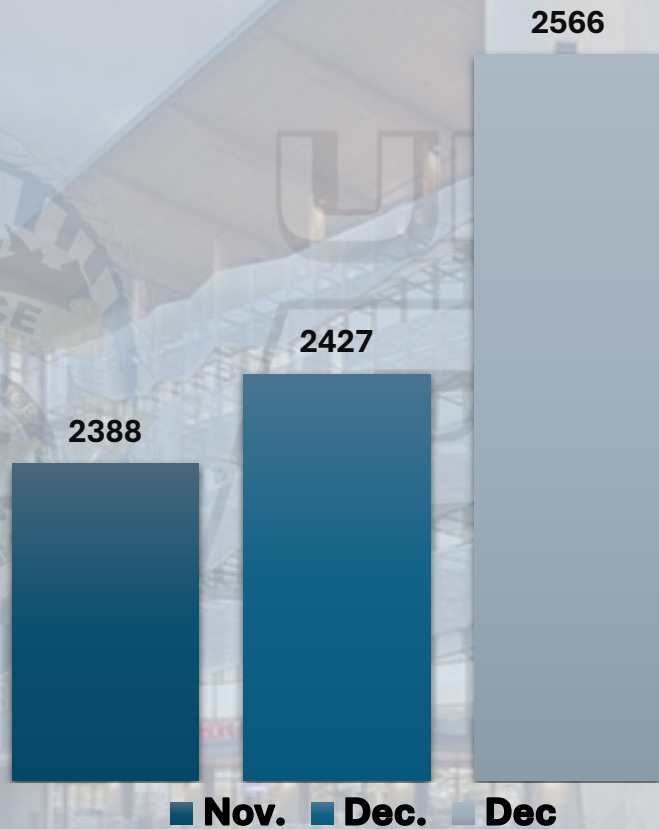




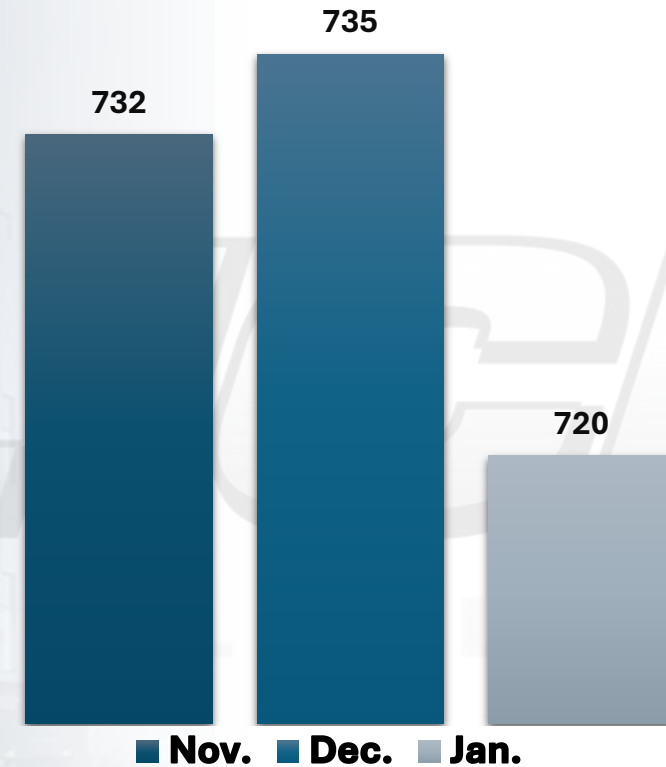

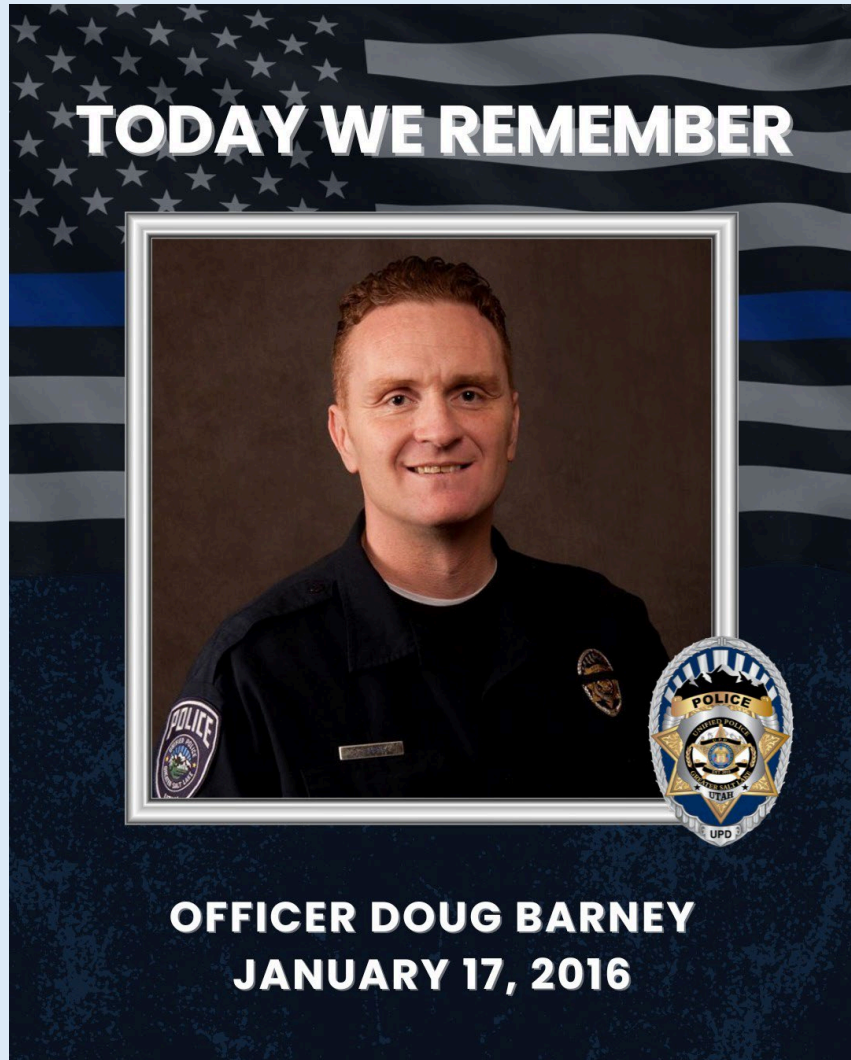

Sobre la obra

Water Path Histories responde a Mill Creek, el curso de agua natural que fluye desde Millcreek Canyon y pasa junto al Millcreek Community Center. Las formas de acero cortado con láser siguen el movimiento y las curvas del arroyo, reflejando su papel histórico en la vida cotidiana y el desarrollo de la zona.

Integradas en la estructura se encuentran fotografías históricas del pasado de Millcreek, incluidas imágenes del Molino de Millcreek y de los primeros agricultores pioneros afroamericanos. Al entrelazar estas imágenes dentro de las formas metálicas fluidas, la obra conecta los sistemas naturales con las historias humanas, y destaca cómo la tierra, el agua y la comunidad han estado profundamente entrelazadas a lo largo del tiempo.



Sobre la artista

Lenka Konopasek es una pintora y artista de medios mixtos nacida en la República Checa. Su trabajo a menudo explora desastres naturales y provocados por el ser humano, y cómo las personas responden al cambio y la pérdida.

Konopasek obtuvo su Licenciatura en Bellas Artes en la Universidad de Utah y su Maestría en Bellas Artes en el Maine College of Art. Ha exhibido su obra en todo Estados Unidos, Taiwán, Alemania, India y la República Checa. Su trabajo ha sido presentado en *New American Paintings*, *Studio Visit Magazine* y otras publicaciones.

Ha realizado varios proyectos de arte público de gran escala en Utah y actualmente enseña arte de estudio en la Universidad de Utah y en Westminster University.

About the Artwork

Water Path Histories responds to Mill Creek, the natural waterway that flows from Millcreek Canyon past the Millcreek Community Center. The laser-cut steel forms follow the movement and curves of the creek, reflecting its long role in the area's history and daily life.

Embedded within the structure are historical photographs from Millcreek's past, including images of the Millcreek Mill and early Black pioneer farmers. By weaving these images into flowing metal forms, the artwork connects natural systems with human stories. It highlights how land, water, and community are deeply connected over time.



About the Artist

Lenka Konopasek is a Czech-born painter and mixed media artist. Her work often explores the impact of natural and human-made disasters, and how people respond to change and loss.

Konopasek earned her Bachelor of Fine Arts from the University of Utah and her Master of Fine Arts from the Maine College of Art. She has exhibited her work throughout the United States, Taiwan, Germany, India, and the Czech Republic. Her work has been featured in *New American Paintings*, *Studio Visit Magazine*, and other publications.

She has completed several large public art projects in Utah and currently teaches studio art at the University of Utah and Westminster University.

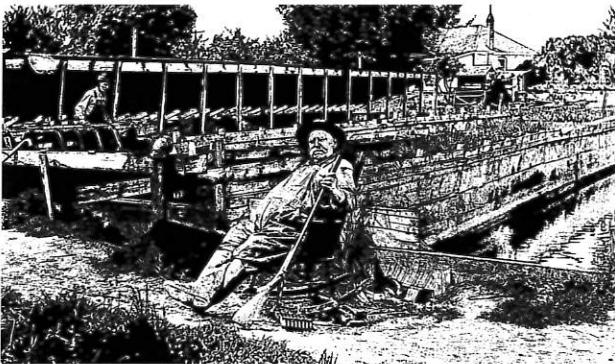

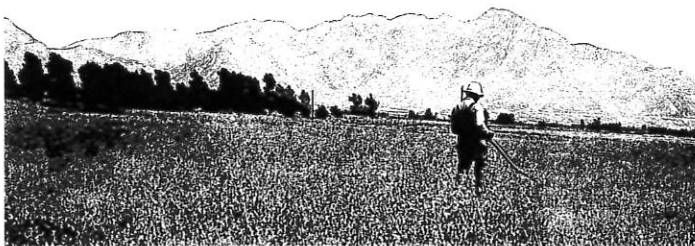
