Town Hearing Discussion: Public comments regarding a proposal for water leak insurance. Mayor Jim would like to know the people feelings on if they would like the town to proceed with this. The problem that we are looking at with this ServLine Company is that it is an opt out program. As of today the cost is \$1.75 for \$500.00 coverage per occurrence, \$2.00 for \$1,000.00 coverage per occurrence, \$2.35 for \$2,500.00 coverage per occurrence per month. Everyone will need to sign up which is not popular. There is a 60 day to opt out. A discussion ensued.

Could the town have its own fund to hold money for this propose? That would be something to ask the town Lawyer. Does this coverage cover older homes? What percentage of town people need to sign up? How often do the rates raise? May need to look for other companies? Is it easy to opt out? May need to get Dennis @ ServLine on a zoom meeting?
