V. Consider Tax Commission positions on 2026 General Session pending legislation [*action item*]

1. HB 22 Vintage Vehicle Amendments 3rd Sub

In September, the tax commission presented to the Transportation Interim Committee regarding the vintage vehicle program. During the presentation, we highlighted the complexity of the vintage vehicle provisions in the motor vehicle code. While the tax commission did not request legislation in our presentation, we appreciate the clarifications made the vintage vehicle provisions of the motor vehicle code in Third Substitute HB 22, Vintage Vehicle Amendments, because they reduce complexity and simplify administration of the program. Specifically, we support:

- restructuring the existing vintage vehicle program into a new "classic vehicle" program;
- elimination of some of the more complex, use-based qualification standards; and
- enactment of an age-based distinction that is simple for the public to understand and easier for the motor vehicle division to administer.

The tax commission was not involved in the following changes in HB 22, Vintage Vehicle Amendments:

- elimination of the issuance of a special group license plate for a vintage vehicle;
- removal of the exemption for a vintage vehicle from the voluntary contribution to the historical support special group license plate;
- an exemption for all motor vehicles made in 1995 or earlier from the emissions inspection program; and
- an exemption for a motor vehicle that cannot be tested with an on-board diagnostic system from the emissions inspection program.

MOTION: Commissioner Rockwell moved that the Commission support the provisions of Third Substitute HB 22, Vintage Vehicle Amendments, pertaining to restructuring the vintage vehicle program into a new "classic vehicle" program, eliminating some of the more complex, use-based qualification standards, and enacting an age-based distinction.

Commissioner Valentine took a roll call vote and the motion passed unanimously
