

**Rockville Town Council
Regular Meeting
Rockville Town Hall
February 11, 2026 – 6:00 pm**

1. **CALL TO ORDER-ROLL CALL:** Mayor Leach called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. The following Town Council members were present: Andy Efstratis, Robin Smith, Megan Honer-Orton, Jeff Ballard and Mayor Pam Leach. Clerk Cox was recording the meeting.
2. **PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE:** Mayor Leach led the Pledge of Allegiance.

5. **REPORT ON HURRICANE VALLEY FIRE SPECIAL SERVICE DISTRICT – MAYOR LEACH:** Mayor Leach reported the call numbers for January in the absence of Chief Tyler Ames. Rockville had zero (0) calls. Springdale had five (5) calls. Zion National Park had three (3) calls.
6. **REPORT ON RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE PLANNING COMMISSION CHAIRMAN REPORT- TIM ARNOLD:** Mayor Leach asked Tim Arnold, the new Chairman of the Planning Commission to update the Council on last night's Planning Commission meeting. Chairman Arnold said he was elected Chairman with Linda Brinkley elected as Vice Chairman for 2026. He said after the regular meeting a work meeting was held and there was a presentation regarding proper procedures and conduct training for Planning Commission meetings for the Commissioners.

Chairman Arnold said he had been doing a complete index of the Land Use Code page by page. He is cross-indexing all the definitions used within the Land Use Code. In doing this he found there are 43 terms that are in the definitions that do not appear anywhere in the Land Use Code, which is really interesting, like "boxcar". Chair Arnold said he didn't remember when the last time we had a boxcar in Town. He said the Code may need to be amended to change the index. He said he has formatted it so you can look up the definition and find the exact page numbers that it's located on and where it is in the Code. Now you have the term, the definition, and then you can find it right in the Code wherever you want. Mayor Leach thanked him for completing this large project.

Administrative Non-Action Items

REPORTS OF MAYOR AND COUNCIL MEMBERS

Andy Efstratis said he is working on his mosquito certifications and should be done soon. He is still in the process to be officially appointed to the various Boards and so had nothing to report from their meetings.

Robin Smith reported the Town of Springdale is holding an information workshop next week to discuss the new Wildland Urban Interface and invited anyone to attend. She will forward the invitation to the Office to be sent out to the Rockville residents.

Megan Honer-Orton reported the Air Quality Control meeting scheduled for today had been canceled. She also reported she had two (2) new members who have requested to join the CERT Team, which stemmed from the Preparedness Fair last fall in Springdale.

Jeff Ballard reported he had contacted Brad Quinn, a stone mason, to get a bid to cover the rock ditch with flagstone in front of the Town Office and the Post Office as it presents a major problem trying to step over the ditch. The plan would extend the cover from the West driveway to the small walking bridge in front of the Town Hall.

Jeff Ballard indicated the Town needs a new small dump truck to replace the existing one. Various options are being evaluated. He said new traffic cones are also needed and prices are being reviewed. Jeff Ballard reported he had used the backhoe to work on the access off SR 9 to the Cemetery and the road itself as the road had gotten extremely rough. He may need to place additional gravel there also.

Mayor Leach reminded the Council of the annual Public Officials training next Wednesday in Virgin at the Autocamp facility. She said Five County Association of Governments will be presenting on some very helpful subjects.

Mayor Leach reported she had attended online the Legislative Transportation Steering Committee meeting this week. They are reviewing HCR007, a House Concurrent Resolution requesting approval of an update to a

Corridor Management Plan (CMP) for the Zion National Scenic Byway. The Committee voted to move this to the House with a recommendation to approve. The approval of the Concurrent Resolution by the Legislature is necessary to allow the byway to be nominated for designation as an All-American Road, which is the highest National Road designation. Andy Efstratis asked how long the projected time frame is once submitted for the road designation to be approved. Mayor Leach said there is no set time as of yet.

Mayor Leach reminded the Council the annual Appreciation Breakfast will be held Saturday, February 21, 2026 at the Community Center beginning at 9:00 am to 10:00 am.
Mayor Leach reported the annual Water Board meetings have been set for Monday, March 9, 2026 beginning at 5:30 pm and will be held in the Town Hall.






