

PARKS, TRAILS, AND RECREATION COMMITTEE MINUTES

Wednesday, January 7, 2026 at 7:00 PM at 1020 East Pioneer Road, Draper, Utah 84020 in the Administration Conference Room.

1. **Approval of 11-5-2025 Minutes**– Motion by Doug Ovard, seconded by Jason Wiggins, to approve the minutes. Motion passed unanimously.
2. **2026 Park and Trail Projects** – Brad Jensen reviewed the completed, existing, proposed, and potential park and trail projects for 2026. Motion by Jamie Pogue, seconded by Doug Ovard, to recommend the projects presented and include a new downhill bike only trail from Peak View Trailhead in the upper Corner Canyon area. Motion passed unanimously.
3. **2025 Trail Use Statistics** – Greg Hilbig reviewed the past year trail use statistics.
4. **Committee/Staff reports**

Greg Hilbig discussed the upcoming mountain bike race scheduled for June 6th, and the need for the committee’s assistance.

Jamie Pogue discussed the need to look at more signage on the Lower Corner Canyon Road, near the diversion and Jungle Trail to direct hikers to stay right. Greg to look into doing more signage in the area.

Josh Christensen mentioned the fact that Woods Hollow Trail has become more rocky over time, and more difficult for young riders.

Jason Wiggins asked about the lack of hiking access to Movie Rock. Some discussion regarding a user trail that has developed over time, but is not officially recognized. Greg mentioned that any access would be on Forest Service land and would reach out to them again.

A question came up regarding painted rocks on trails. Greg Hilbig said that they can be removed.
