

MINUTES OF THE STUDY SESSION – FEBRUARY 25, 2026

The Board of Education of the Timpanogos School District met in a study session on Wednesday, February 25, 2026, at 4:32 pm. The study session took place in the meeting room of the ASD SPED office in Lindon, UT.

Board members present: President Jennifer Lyman, Vice President Sterling Hilton, Guy Fugal, Grace Rex, and David H. Smith. Remote: Michelle Sorensen & Ada Wilson.

Also present: Superintendent Jensen. There were approximately 18 others in attendance.

Alpine School District Preschool Program

Heather Slaymaker and Dr. Royd Darrington provided a presentation to the Board of Education regarding the current preschool program within Alpine School District, outlining services for students eligible under an IEP, those who qualify for Title I, and those enrolled through tuition only. They reviewed the federal mandate requiring preschool services for qualifying students and explained the associated funding structure noting that the district was not awarded the applicable grant for this year. They further clarified that the tuition-only preschool program will be discontinued for the 2026–2027 school year in order to prioritize federally mandated services. The presenters also outlined anticipated program modifications for 2026–2027, including the removal of certain preschool programs from specific school sites, noting that the inclusion classes will allow for tuition only students if there is capacity to do so.

Heather Slaymaker and Dr. Royd Darrington fielded questions from the Board of Education.
