AGENDA ITEM SUMMARY: LIMIT 150 WORDS	The City manages stormwater through its Municipal Stormwater Management Program under its MS4 permit. The program is funded in part through a monthly storm water utility fee. City Administration has studied and recommended increasing the fee from Four Dollars to Six Dollars per equivalent residential unit to support ongoing maintenance, regulatory compliance, and infrastructure needs. The City Council held a public hearing on March 4, 2026. The updated fee will take effect April 1, 2026.

**RESOLUTION NO. 26-05**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF TAYLORSVILLE**  
**APPROVING AN UPDATED STORM WATER FEE**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Taylorsville City Council (the “Council”) met in regular session on March 18, 2026, to consider, among other matters, an adjustment to the storm water fee; and

**WHEREAS**, The City of Taylorsville manages stormwater through its Municipal Stormwater Management Program, which focuses on stormwater quality, regulatory compliance, and infrastructure maintenance; and

**WHEREAS**, the City operates this program pursuant to a Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System permit issued by the Utah Department of Environmental Quality as part of compliance with applicable state and federal law; and

**WHEREAS**, the program addresses runoff management, pollution prevention, and the maintenance of infrastructure including storm drains, catch basins, conveyance systems, and related stormwater facilities; and

**WHEREAS**, the effective management of stormwater is essential to protecting water quality, public infrastructure, and the health, safety, and welfare of the community; and

**WHEREAS**, the collection of stormwater utility fees is necessary to fund the continued operation, maintenance, and regulatory compliance of the City’s stormwater management program; and

**WHEREAS**, the Council finds that periodic adjustments to such fees are necessary to ensure the continued viability and financial sustainability of the program; and

**WHEREAS**, the current monthly storm water fee is Four Dollars (\$4.00) per equivalent residential unit; and

**WHEREAS**, the City conducted a study of the stormwater utility which concluded that an adjustment to the monthly stormwater fee is necessary, and City Administration has recommended setting the monthly stormwater fee at Six Dollars (\$6.00); and

**WHEREAS**, notice of the proposed storm water fee adjustment was provided in accordance with applicable law, and the City Council held a public hearing to consider this matter on March 4, 2026; and

**WHEREAS**, after consideration of the information presented and the public comment received, the Council has determined that approval of the adjustment to the storm

water fee, is in the best interest of the general health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Taylorsville City.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Taylorsville City Council as follows:**

**Section 1. Approval of Stormwater Fee Adjustment.** The City Council hereby approves an adjustment to the monthly stormwater fee from Four Dollars (\$4.00) to Six Dollars (\$6.00).

**Section 2. Effective Date.** The adjusted stormwater fee adopted by this Resolution shall take effect on April 1, 2026.

**Section 3. Implementation.** City Administration is authorized and directed to take all administrative actions necessary to implement this resolution.
