




Q4 FOUR YEAR MONTHLY COMPARISON






INCOMING UNITS QUARTER 4










Community Risk Reduction Safety Messages

Smoke Detectors and Carbon Monoxide Alarms

- Early Warnings for Both Fire and Carbon Monoxide Save Lives
- Regular Testing Keeps Everyone Safe
- A Complete Safety Approach






Community Risk Reduction Safety Messages

HANDS ONLY CPR

- Most Cardiac Arrest occur in the home
- Time Matters
 - Tissue damage begins in 4-6 minutes
 - EMS Response times
 - Early Bystander CPR can increase odds of survival
- No mouth to mouth
- Easy to perform





Community Risk Reduction Safety Messages

HANDS ONLY CPR

- 2024 UFA responded to 252 Non-Traumatic Cardiac Arrest cases
 - 52.8% received bystander CPR
 - 11.5% had AED applied
 - 31 patients left the hospital alive after receiving both
 - 51.6 % save rate (national average is 37.6%)
