
# Vehicle Accident Update






# Six Remnant Defendants National Opioid Settlement

# Highlights of the Six Remnant Defendants National Opioid Settlement

- \$97,625,000.00 combined will be paid by the Six Remnant Defendants in cash for purposes of abating the opioid epidemic
- Clearfield is a qualifying city because we have a population greater than 30K
- Unlike prior Opioid Settlements, this settlement does not include State Attorneys General or any amount allocated to the State
- Settlement Formula: City receives 0.0073415897% of \$97,625,000.00, or \$7,167.23
- City is restricted as to how we can spend the \$7,167.23
  - Still exploring, but likely public awareness campaign or law enforcement training
