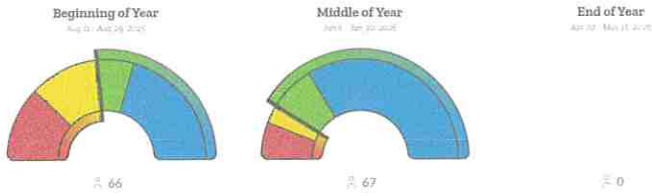

Of Note: We are currently on track for the school year with a typical amount of movement for this point in the school year. Transition patterns are not specific to one grade, teacher, or concern.

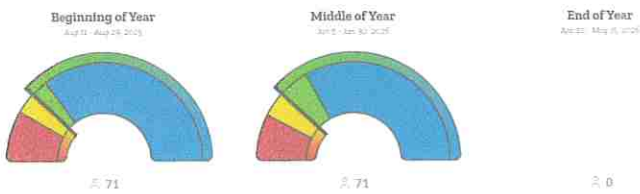

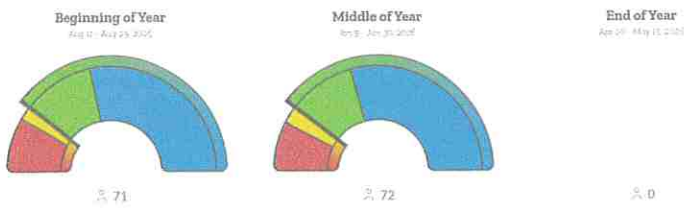

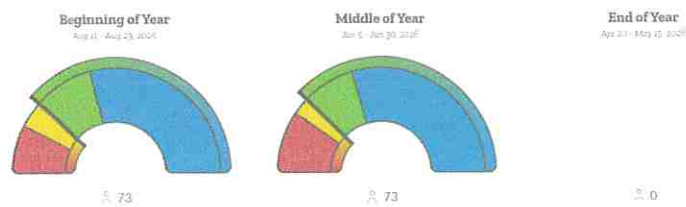
