The meeting was called to order at 6:32 p.m. by Mayor Greg Pearson.

Minutes for the January 2026 meeting were reviewed. A typographical error was found and the clerk will change it.

The open and close training for meetings was done. The clerk will send it to each Councilmember to complete for a certificate to be printed.

No new update on the roads. Just checking to see if it is ready to go out on bids.

Mayor Greg Pearson reported on the fire department. He stated that they will hold a wildland refresher on Saturday February 28. After the refresher they will have a controlled burn over in Kingston. They will also need to do some burning on the old church farm road. But that is scheduled for a later date.

The water department was discussed. There was a fire hydrant that was leaking. It is fixed for now but there are a few around town that will eventually need to be replaced. Overdue water bills and the policy was reviewed and discussed. The clerk read the letters that are sent out to those on the list each month. The letter of concern and disconnect notice have a few updates about times and dates on them. The clerk will send out two letters of disconnect.

MOTION: Made by Councilman LeRell Barnson to update the letters and to have a copy for the Sheriffs department for when they need to help with the disconnect.

The roads were discussed. The flashing speed limit sign had a wal mart battery replaced in it and it is working well. The clerk will pick up a couple more batteries to have on hand. Some new street signs need to be ordered. Councilman Coy Morrison will see what signs need to be ordered and get a list to the clerk.

Cemetery was discussed. Councilmember Mandy Larsen will talk to Sherm Buck about the extra flag he had for the cemetery. The airport was discussed. They will check the gate to make sure that it is shut and locked.

Nothing to report on the park. The clerk did mention that Noah stated last fall that his sprayer was broken and that he owed the town one spray.

Councilmember Jodi Hurdsman discussed the Easter Egg Hunt. The discussion of changing it to 3 groups was discussed. The board agreed to just do three age groups: 0-3, 4-7, and 8-12. The clerk will contact Kingston Town to see if they still plan on going in on the egg hunt. The board will like to have donuts and juice again. The budget for the egg hunt has been \$650. The board would like to increase the amount due to the cost of things going up.

MOTION: Made by Councilman Coy Morrison to up the budget for the Easter Egg Hunt to \$750.


The financial statement and bank statement for the month of January were available for review.
