ORDINANCE 2026-01**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE VINEYARD CITY COUNCIL AMENDING THE  
VINEYARD MUNICIPAL CODE TITLE 3 CHAPTER .02 SECTION 010(1)**

**WHEREAS**, The Vineyard City Council under the authority of Utah Code 10-3 has the right to amend the municipal code; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council desires to changing the day of the week that the City Council will hold its regular meetings from the second and fourth Wednesdays to the second and fourth Tuesdays of each month, beginning at 6:00 PM.

**WHEREAS**, the City Council has determined it is in the best interest of the citizens of the city to amend Title 3 Chapter 2 , section 010 as stated above.

**NOW THEREFORE**, be it ordained by the Council of the Vineyard, in the State of Utah, as follows:

**SECTION 1:**        **AMENDMENT** “3.02.010 Time, Place; Exceptions” of the Vineyard Municipal Code is hereby *amended* as follows:

AMENDMENT

3.02.010 Time, Place; Exceptions

~~Except as may be adjusted according to the procedures contained in this chapter, the city council shall hold two (2) regular meeting(s) on the second and fourth Wednesdays of each month at the offices of the municipality, which meeting(s) shall begin promptly at 6 o'clock PM provided that:~~

- A. ~~If the meeting date is a legal holiday, then the meeting shall be canceled; and~~ The city council shall, by resolution, publish the annual city council schedule.
- B. The city council may, by resolution, provide for a different time and place for holding regular meetings of the governing body.

**SECTION 2: REPEALER CLAUSE** All ordinances or resolutions or parts thereof, which are in conflict herewith, are hereby repealed.

**SECTION 3: SEVERABILITY CLAUSE** Should any part or provision of this Ordinance be declared by the courts to be unconstitutional or invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the Ordinances a whole or any part thereof other than the part so declared to be unconstitutional or invalid.

**SECTION 4: EFFECTIVE DATE** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from January 20, 2026, and after the required approval and publication according to law.
