Matters for Discussion

1. Discussion: Budget Amendment

Finance Director, Crystal Makin, reviewed the proposed amendments to the following funds.

- a. General Fund
- b. Public Safety Special Revenue Fund
- c. Capital Fund
- d. Water Fund
- e. Sewer Fund
- f. Stormwater Fund

2. Discussion: Addition of 600 West Standard Road Profile to Chapter 17-10 of Land Use Development Code

Senior Planner, Spencer Cawley, reviewed the proposed standard road profile for 600 West that was also reviewed by the Planning Commission.

The proposed standards would include two 12’ lanes, two 5’ bike paths, a 6’ park strip, an 8’ park strip, one 5’ sidewalk, two 2.5’ Type A curbs and gutters, and a 1’ PUE/Utility.

The Planning Commission forwarded a positive recommendation for consideration.

Formal action will be considered at a future meeting.

3. Discussion: Tracy Aviary Code Amendment to Allow Previous Surfaces

Community Development Deputy Director, Eliza Ungricht, reviewed the proposed amendment that would amend the parking requirements at Tracy Aviary’s Jordan River Nature Center and allow permeable surfaces.
