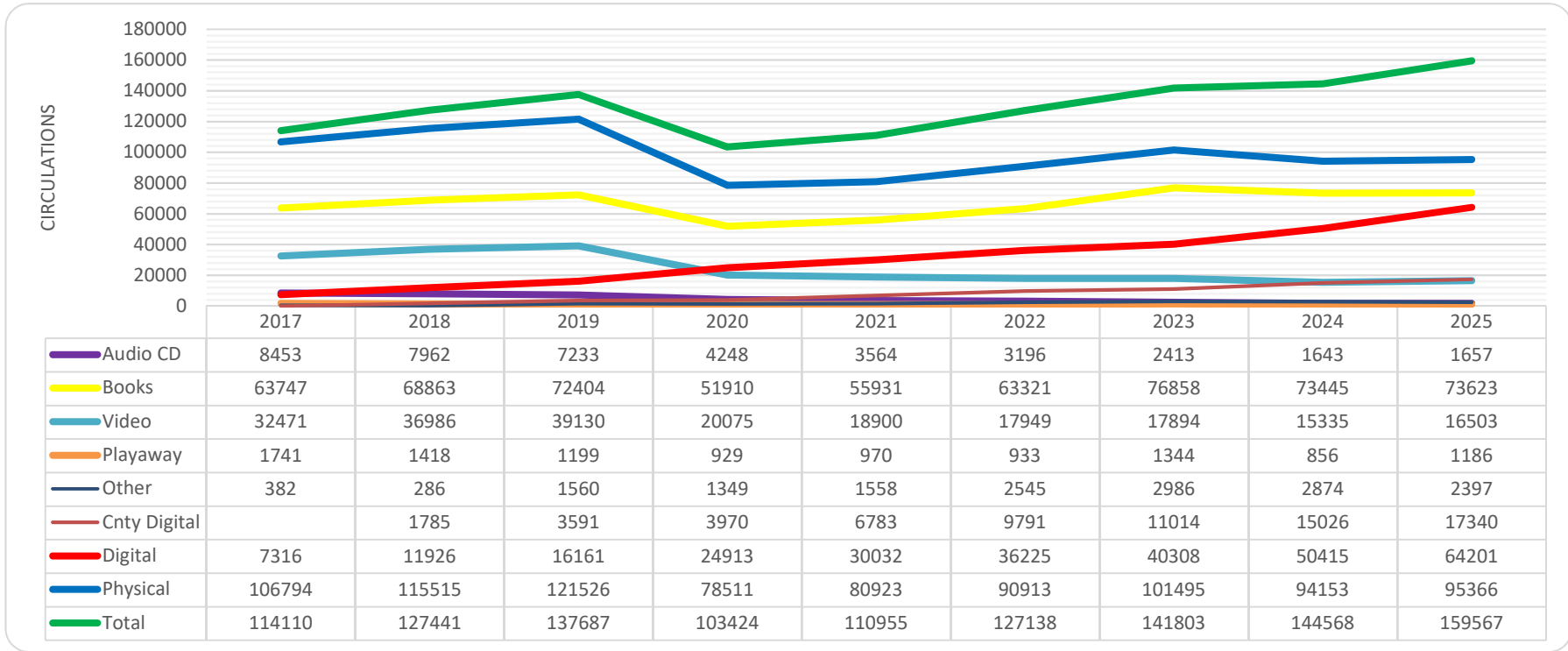

\*Circulation of books has remained strong over the past decade.

\*Since 2017, CD use has dropped 80%, correlated with migration to digital audio collections.

\*Video dropped by 49% after streaming services arose during COVID. Since that significant change though, video has only decreased 13% since 2021, likely correlated with the need some residents have to borrow videos when they can't afford streaming services. Videos are still 17% of physical circulation.

\*Playaways have fluctuated the last few years as new items have focused on younger audiences. Guarantors may prefer the MP3 player over devices that require the Libby/Hoopla/Blackstone apps.
