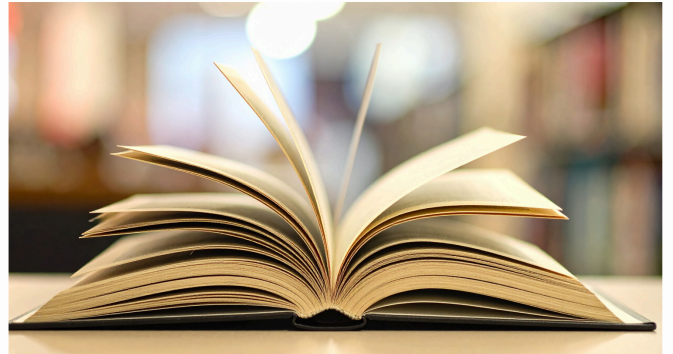
# 2025 HIGHLIGHTS



# Circulation

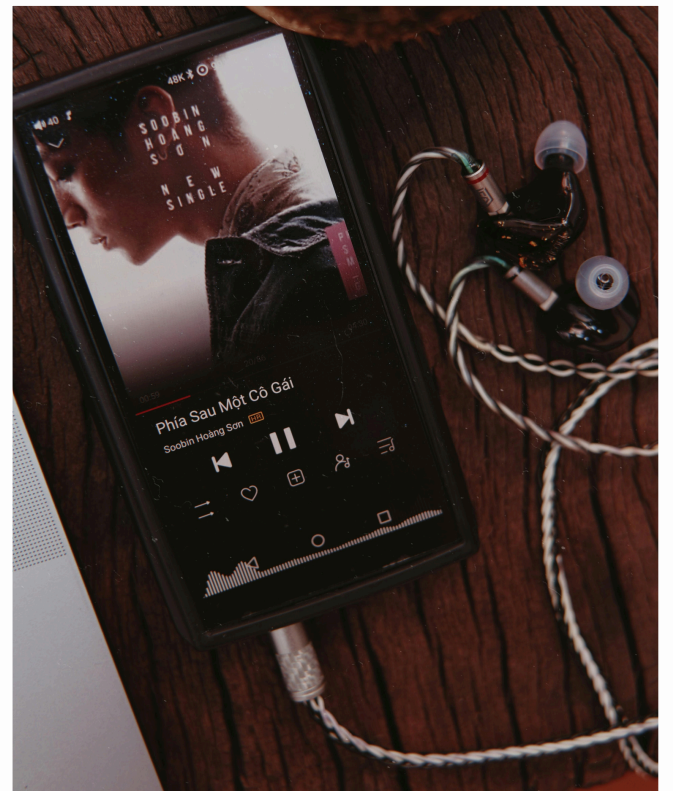
## Physical

- 95,000 Total
- 77% are books & remain steady over the past decade.
- 43,000 Children's Materials



## Digital

- 64,000 Total
- 47,000 from Beehive Libby Consortium
- Blackstone Unlimited audiobooks launched
