I am writing to request the installation of a public trash can at a high-traffic point on **Waterfront Dr**. Specifically, the best location would be at the **end of the railing closest to 207 S Waterfront Dr**, directly in front of the steps that lead down to the Virgin River trail and the skimboard park.

Because this spot serves as a primary entrance for the skimboard park and the trail system, it sees significant foot traffic. Currently, there is a recurring litter problem in this exact area because visitors have no convenient place to dispose of trash before or after using the stairs.

A permanent bin here would greatly help keep our riverfront and trail system clean. Thank you for your time and for all you do to maintain our city.
