
**Minutes**

Welcome, Call to Order & Roll Call	Vice Chair McMillan called the meeting to order at 4:30pm, conducted roll call, welcomed, and thanked everyone for attending.
Minutes	Vice Chair McMillan asked for a motion to approve November 17, 2026, minutes. Member Silberman motioned to approve, seconded by Member Hanna. All Approved
Chair Nominations	Member Sorrentino voted to appoint Nic McMillan as the Chair of OTN. Seconded by Member Warren. All approved. Chair McMillan voted to appoint Jim Judeikas as the Vice Chair of OTN. Seconded by Member Sorrentino. All approved.
Office Updates	<p>Pump Track – Director Stewart stated that we have applied for CIP funds in the amount of \$350,000.00. The City is still working to complete the property transfers. He mentioned there is an opportunity to apply for a no-match grant in July. He took the Administration down to a few parks in Lehi, Provo area, that have tracks.</p> <p>E-Bikes – It was reported that the E-Motorcycles are out of control on the trails. It was asked that we look into doing a social media post, educating people on what is and is not allowed.</p> <p>TFNU – There has been some discussion about having the OTN move to TFNU as a subcommittee. The committee discussed some of the positives</p>

	<p>– Funding, equipment use. One concern was losing the passion, ownership, team feeling that OTN has. Director Stewart ask everyone to send an email with how each member feels about the ideas, what they feel would work, and what they are concerned about. So we can make sure everything is addressed.</p>
<p>USFS Updates</p>	<p>The Forest Service is preparing for some restructuring. Zack Maughan is the current acting Ranger until approximately May. They are looking at planning some projects with TFNU. He stated that they are not planning to apply for many DOR Grants. Now is a good time for the OTN to look into getting some funds, less competition. The OTN Agreement with the USFS has expired. He will work with Staff Olsen and Director Stewart to get a new one in place. Chair McMillan mentioned a trail route he has shared with TFNU that he is hoping to have reviewed.</p>
<p>Committee Member Applications</p>	<p>Staff Olsen stated that Member Goodrick has asked to be removed from a voting member to a subcommittee. The committee ask that Member Gentry also be removed as a voting member. This gives us two open positions. Staff Olsen shared three applications that have been submitted.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Aubrey McIntosh</li> <li>• Garrett Russell</li> <li>• Kimberly Haslam</li> </ul> <p>The committee decided to email Staff Olsen with their top two choices. She will do a tally and send the recommended members to the administration and request they be appointed.</p>
<p>Pliking</p>	<p>Member Sorrentino stated that they cleaned the Dime and Ring Trail and Botanical Gardens. They are planning to do that trail again in late March. They also cleaned Antelope Island. 29<sup>th</sup> Street Trailhead is scheduled for late May.</p>
<p>Projects</p>	<p>Parking Lot Survey – The City asked the committee members if they would take some time to look at the different Trailhead Parking lots and note any repairs or cleanup that may be needed. Staff Olsen will send out a check list. Each committee member selected the trailheads they would look at.</p> <p>Trail Counters – Chair McMillan said he would gather all the different counters, get them brought back to the office so we can reset them, replace batteries and get them relocated.</p> <p>Adaptive Course – Member Harris stated that if TFNU does not do an Adaptive Course, we should look at possibly widening Gibb’s Loop and doing some reroutes that will make elevation changes more manageable.</p> <p>Shindig – The committee decided to not host the Shindig. They would rather host several small events throughout the year. The first one they would like to do is May 8, The RUT Race. Staff Olsen asked Chair</p>

Committee Updates	<p>Member Warren stated that the committee should work on Strong's Canyon this year. The trail is sluffed over.</p> <p>Member Warren would also like to sit down and work on revamping the Adopt a Trail program.</p> <p>Member Sparks would like to try and spark enthusiasm in the Trail Ambassador Program</p> <p>Planning Commission Williams asked what the results were from the trail survey. Staff Olsen stated that from memory, it was about 52% against a trail through the course. Which led to a discussion about events concerning the public crossing the field of play along the golf course.</p>
Adjourn	Vice Chair McMillian motioned to adjourn. Seconded by Member Judeikis, all approved. The Trails Network meeting concluded at 5:20pm.
