

REQUEST FOR COUNCIL ACTION

SUBJECT:

A RESOLUTION APPROPRIATING FROM THE GENERAL GOVERNMENT BUDGET ACCOUNT \$29,000 FOR PUBLIC RELATIONS AND MEDIA SUPPORT OF AMENDING THE UTAH CODE TO ALLOW AUTOMOBILE DEALERSHIPS TO LOCATE WITHIN THE CITY.

SUMMARY:

The Mayor and City Manager proposed to use the \$29,000 that the City has saved by the Mayor foregoing that amount of salary over the past 12 months to support purchasing goods and services necessary to mobilize public support for the amendment of the Utah Code to allow automobile dealerships to locate within the City.

FISCAL IMPACT:

\$29,000 would be appropriated from the General Government budget account. Staff believes that such an appropriation will not render this budget account overbudget.

A RESOLUTION APPROPRIATING FROM THE GENERAL GOVERNMENT BUDGET ACCOUNT \$29,000 FOR PUBLIC RELATIONS AND MEDIA SUPPORT OF AMENDING THE UTAH CODE TO ALLOW AUTOMOBILE DEALERSHIPS TO LOCATE WITHIN THE CITY.

Whereas, the Mayor has voluntarily foregone \$29,000 in salary during the calendar year 2014; and

Whereas, the City Council supports amendments to the Utah Code to enable one or more car automobile dealerships to locate within the City; and

Whereas, the effort to so amend the Utah Code will require public relations and public affairs time and charges to create a public awareness and participation; and

Whereas, the Mayor is soliciting funding for this effort from neighboring cities on the Western portion of Salt Lake County,

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF WEST JORDAN, UTAH:

Section 1. The City Council hereby appropriates \$29,000 from the General Government Budget account for expenditure as directed by the City Manager for the purpose of purchasing public affairs and public relations goods and services in support of amending the Utah Code to allow automobile dealerships to locate within the City.

Section 2. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
