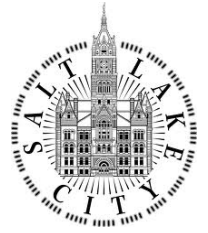

General Information: We are seeing more loads being securely covered, still a lot of residential loads coming in not covered. Need clarification on a few types of loads from UHP, specifically how they would view semi-trucks with large items, house framing wood and large wooden spools that are secured but not covered. We have added additional signage at the landfill entrance to alert people to the new secure cover requirements. John Ioannou (Yianni) has submitted papers for retirement for the end of this month. Will be discussing with the mayor's office the future of this position. Council Board Members express their congratulations to John Ioannou (Yianni).

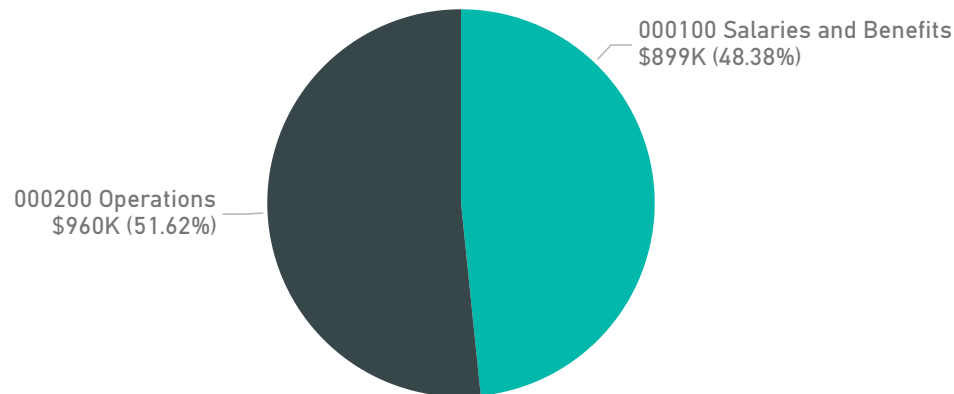

Expenses by Expense Type



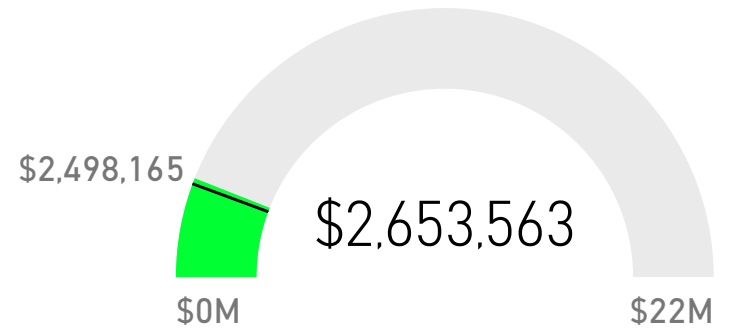

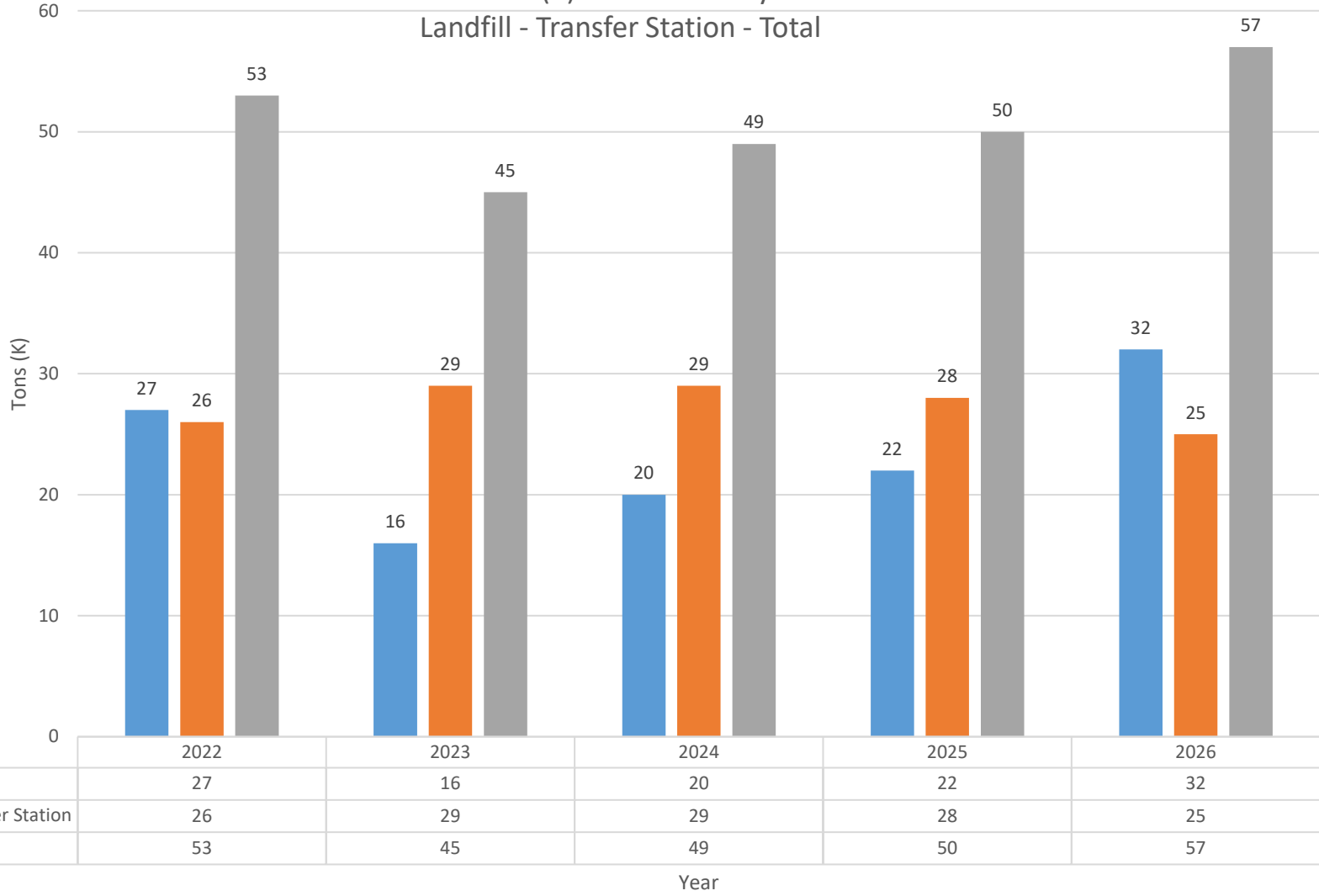

LANDFILL REVENUE RECEIVED VS EXPEC...



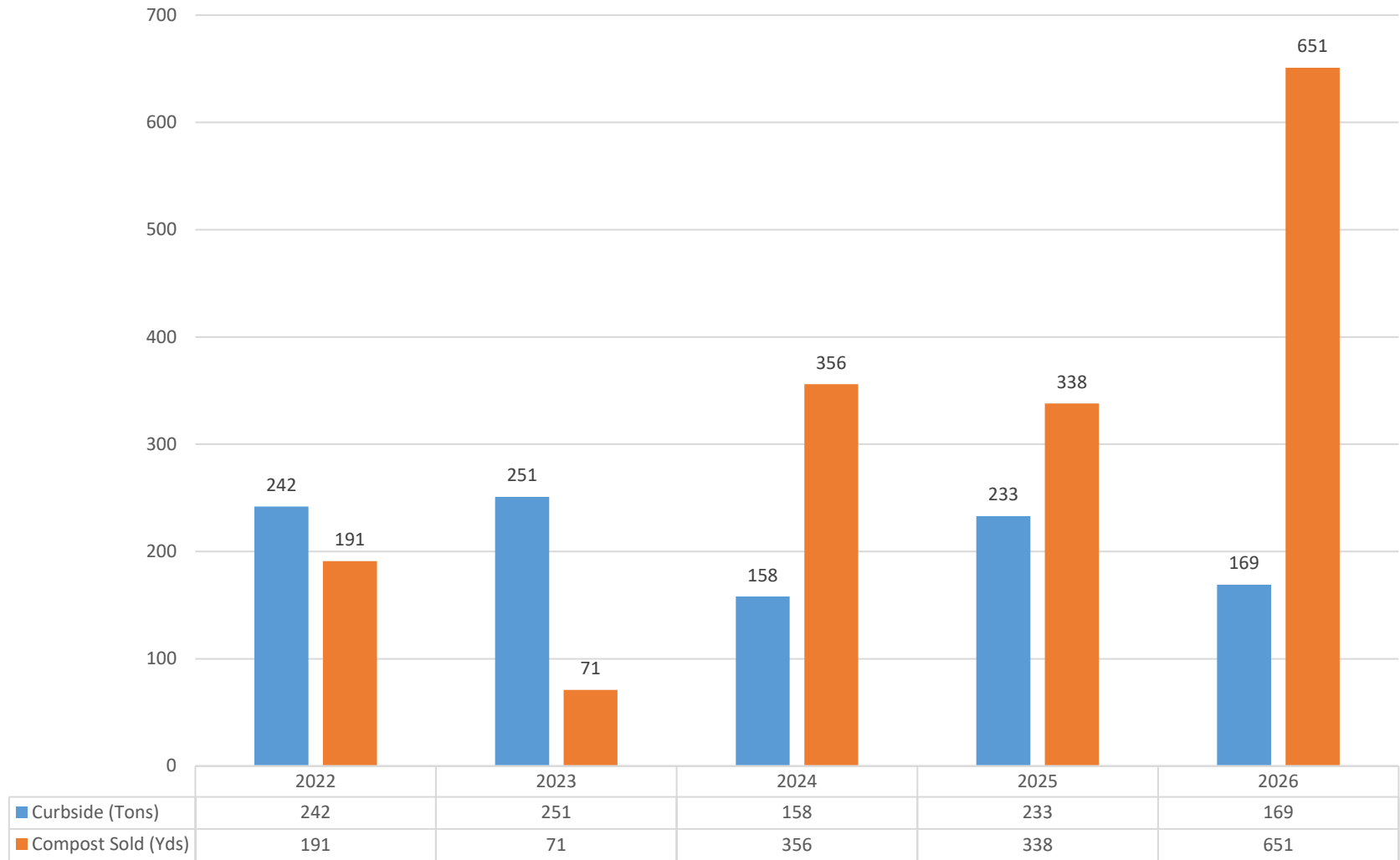
MSW Tons (K) - YTD February 2026
