APPROVAL OF MEETING MINUTES

REPORTS/ACTION ITEMS

Open and Public Meeting Act Training

Mr. Nelson appeared before the board and gave the yearly required training regarding open and public meetings act training. This included meeting posting requirements, what constitutes a quorum, general meeting practices, etc. He concluded by stating that even texts between multiple board members can be subject to GRAMA requests and warns to be careful in large group chats, etc.

Truck Purchase Decision

Chief Gray presented the board with a list of different options for purchasing a new vehicle for the police department. These vehicle options were all trucks, but varied in from the dealer packages.

Mr. Welch suggested the department stay away from the already installed police packages as they don't tend to be as nice.

Mr. Welch moved to approve of any of the options listed and gave Chief Gray the discretion to choose which vehicle was best for the department. **Mr. Lynn seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.**

Draft Budget Review

Mr. Nelson presented the board with the tentative draft budget for the fiscal year of 2026-2027. He expressed how he expects this budget to change significantly in the coming months, but just wanted to keep the board updated with the draft progress.

General discussion ensued regarding the budgetary process, raises, police service fees, etc. Mr. Nelson concluded the item by stating the budget would be back before the board for the draft approval in either April or May.
