**6:00 P.M. Regular Meeting**

The meeting was called to order at 6:00 P.M.

**Item: 1      Approve Minutes from the January 27, 2026, meeting.**

Continued to March meeting due to lack of quorum

**Item: 2      Public Comment Period.**

Sarah deLahunta attended from San Jose, California and said she was happy to be here.

**Item: 3      Mia Yue, Executive Director of Wasatch Trails Foundation**

Did not attend. Katie Villani will reach out to see if she wants to be placed on the March agenda.

**Item: 4      Proposed Budget 2026-2027**

Based upon the recommendation of the City Engineer, \$45,000 for Parks, Trails & Trees was recommended to the City Council for the budget. This is consistent with budget

amounts for the past several years. Nancy O'Toole has advised she will write for a Recreation Restoration Infrastructure Grant to match those funds. Angie Richardson asked if these funds are general or earmarked. Katie Villani explained that they are not specified in the budget but are usually earmarked based upon direction from Wes Johnson (City Engineer) working with Preston Broadhead and the Mayor and City Council. Mayor Simons advised that some of the funds will likely go toward maintenance of Homestead trails. Preston Broadhead advised that remaining funds may go toward resurfacing trails along Burgi Lane and Cari Lane after the water line replacement project is completed.

**Item: 5      Parks and trails update**

Preston Broadhead updated the Committee on trail maintenance after the recent snowstorm. The new snowblower is working well. He is figuring out timing for clearing so he does not have to redo trails after the snowplows make a run. The new trail on North Center Street is working well.

JC Simonsen advised he heard a report that lights were not working in Centennial Park. The Mayor said he would check the lights on his way home after the meeting. JC noted that the new crosswalk on Main at 100 West made the crossing more visible. He appreciates the new dark sky compliant streetlights but noted it is darker on Main Street. He wonders if we should consider additional lights near crosswalks. Committee members can look at the crosswalk areas at night and we can discuss further.

The Committee discussed the potential of doing a trail along Burgi Lane from the west boundary of Valais to Interlaken on the north side of Burgi. There may be some engineering challenges on the western end of Valais due to slope. JC wondered if the trail could be a different height from the road. All agreed a detached trail would be preferable, but that there may be some benefits from an attached trail being done when the road is resurfaced. The Mayor advised that it may be resurfaced as soon as this spring by BD Bush. The Mayor has spoken with Nancy O'Toole regarding potential funding.

Angie Richardson requested a sign update. Katie Villani advised that the first signs have been installed along Homestead Drive. The next City newsletter will include a summary and invite feedback from the public. Additional signs will go up when the weather improves. The Committee discussed having members aid in assembly. Preston advised that the sign at the corner of Homestead Drive and Cari Lane appears to have been knocked over by a car, as there were some car parts near the sign. He believes he can reinstall the sign, which was some distance from the road.

**Item: 6      Open Space Open House April 11, 2026, from 11 AM to 1 PM**

The Open Space Committee will be having an open house in April and PTT is invited to attend and join like they did last year. Katie Villani will send reminders as the date nears.

The meeting adjourned at 6:37 P.M.
