1. Overview of proposed boundary changes affecting East, Enoch, Fiddlers, Iron Springs, North, South and Three Peaks elementary schools; Canyon View and Cedar middle school and Canyon View and Cedar high schools
Business Administrator Todd Hess gave an overview of the proposed boundary changes for East, Enoch, Fiddlers, Iron Springs, North, South and Three Peaks elementary schools as well as Canyon View and Cedar middle schools and Canyon View and Cedar high schools.
2. Public comment on the proposed elementary and secondary school boundary changes
At 6:19 p.m. Vice-President Tullis opened the public hearing.

Sam Peterson, parent of students in the district, asked the timeline for the proposed school boundary changes. Todd Hess explained that the secondary changes would take effect

in the 2027-2028 school year, while elementary changes would begin in the 2026-2027 school year. He also pointed out that families could still request to attend a school outside their boundary, though they would need to provide their own transportation.
