

**UTAH INLAND PORT AUTHORITY
NOTICE OF PROJECT AREA PLAN ADOPTION**

Notice is hereby given that the Utah Inland Port Authority Board (UIPA), acting pursuant to 11-58-501 Utah Code Annotated, approved the following resolution adopting the Black Gold project area with an effective date of March 16, 2026.

**UTAH INLAND PORT AUTHORITY RESOLUTION 2026-18
A RESOLUTION OF THE UTAH INLAND PORT AUTHORITY BOARD ADOPTING THE
BLACK GOLD INLAND PORT PROJECT AREA PLAN**

WHEREAS, pursuant to §11-58-301(1) Utah Code Annotated as amended (“UCA”), the Utah Inland Port Authority (“Authority”) is “governed by a board which shall manage and conduct the business and affairs of the Authority”; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to §11-58-501(2a) UCA, the “The board may adopt a project area plan for land that is outside the authority jurisdictional land,”; and

WHEREAS, the Authority board desires to create the Black Gold Inland Project Area and adopt a new project area plan;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE AUTHORITY BOARD as follows:

1. The Authority board has found and determined that the Black Gold Inland Port project area plan meets the statutory requirements that include the legal description of the boundary of the project area, the purpose and intent with respect to the project area and the board’s finding and determination that
 - a. there is a need for the project to effectuate a public purpose;
 - b. there is a public benefit to the proposed Black Gold Inland Port project;
 - c. it is economically sound and feasible to adopt and carry out the project area plan; and
 - d. carrying out the Black Gold Inland Port project area plan will promote the goals and objectives stated in Subsection §11-58-203(1) UCA.
2. The Authority board hereby: (i) approves the creation of the Black Gold Inland Port project area; and (ii) adopts the Black Gold Inland Port project area plan effective on March 16, 2026.
3. The Duchesne County Assessor, Duchesne County Recorder, and the Duchesne County Treasurer are requested to record this project area with a base year of 2025 in accordance with applicable state law.

PASSED AND ADOPTED by the Authority Board this 16th day of March, 2026.
