Review Budget Mayor Beach has requested that all council members coordinate with their respective department heads to review the current budget as Salina City approaches the end of the fiscal year.

Additionally, please begin preparing for the next fiscal year's budget and identify any necessary changes for the budget meeting scheduled for March 28, at 2:00 pm.

Approval of Sevier County Magazine the Mayor and City Council discussed the Sevier County Magazine advertisement, including the specific events, photos, and information to be featured. Mayor Beach presented the advertising rates, and the Council decided to purchase a full-page ad for \$530.00. **Tammy Hales** said she is happy to help create a page for Salina City and will reach out to Kirk Rasmussen.

Allen Tietjen motioned to approve the purchase of the full-page advertisement for Sevier County Magazine in the amount of \$530.00. **Kevin Mickelsen** seconded. Motion carried 5 to 0.

Approval of additional funds for Police Vehicles Mayor Beach noted that the Salina City Police Department originally overlooked the need to transfer equipment from the current police vehicles to the new ones.

This process will result in an additional cost of a couple hundred dollars per vehicle. Mayor Beach has presented this updated amount to the City Council for review.

Tammy Hales motioned to approve additional funds for the police vehicles total amount of \$12,907.56 and \$17,076.94 for the K-9 unit. **Kevin Mickelsen** seconded. Motion carried 5 to 0.

Discuss Salina City streetlights Mayor Beach has been in contact with Rocky Mountain Power regarding a proposal to switch all city streetlights to LED. Under this plan, Rocky Mountain Power would assume maintenance of the entire system.

Salina City would continue to pay its current rate until the LED conversion is paid off, after which the power bill is expected to decrease. For context, the city paid approximately \$4,500 for streetlights in January. **Mayor Beach** recently placed a work order with Rocky Mountain Power they addressed within hours.

Jorgen Mickelson stated that costs may fluctuate during the transition, the Mayor and Council have agreed to investigate this further. **Mayor Beach** intends to move forward with this change and will present the final figures at the next scheduled meeting for Council review.
