Key Historical Details

Originally Union Pacific Caboose No. 25344 Class CA-6, built November 1955

- Purchased by Utah Railway in 1971 with another caboose for \$10,450
- Operated by the Utah Railway until the early 1990s.
- Coal operations between central Utah mines and Provo.
- Donated to the Boy Scouts of America for use at Camp Jeremiah Johnson in Springville
- In need of restoration to preserve its historical character and ensure safe, long-term use.



OPTIONS FOR RESTORATION AND RELOCATION

Sell to a Private Group

- Coffee/Ice Cream shop in Helper, Utah
- Private family use on property in Springville (800 South backyard)
- Private property in Eureka
- Ogden Train Museum

Restore and place in a local park or museum
