Background:

On February 5, 2026, the Utah Board of Education approved amendments to R277-479 - Funding for Charter School Students with Disabilities on an IEP. The main purpose of the rule change was to cap SPED Add-On Funding for charter schools to per pupil funding levels commensurate with school districts. The rule change exempted from the caps charter schools with more than 60 percent special education students. Spectrum Academy is the only charter school that meets this threshold, with more than 80 percent of its students having an IEP.

The principal reason why Spectrum Academy was exempted from the R277-479 rule change was that the impacts would be many times greater than the impacts for any other charter school.

On February 12, 2025, the State Charter School Board approved the application for Spectrum Academy to add a satellite campus in St. George starting in FY28.

This expansion would require USBE, in accordance with R277-479, to revise down Spectrum Academy's SPED Add-On funding in FY28. The purpose of this item is for the LEA to briefly discuss their expansion plans, the possible ramifications of the rule as currently written, and for the committee to discuss possible ways to move forward.
