RESOLUTION 2026-02

**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF LAKETOWN, UTAH
SUSPENDING TEMPORARILY THE THREE PERCENT (3%) ANNUAL
INCREASE FOR STANDARD MONTHLY AND STANDARD
QUARTERLY WATER SERVICE RATES AS OUTLINED IN THE
TOWN'S FEE SCHEDULE FOR FISCAL YEAR 2026-2027**

WHEREAS, Laketown is a municipal corporation and public water supplier duly organized and existing under the laws of the State of Utah which operates the Town's Water System; and

WHEREAS, §10-3-717 of Utah State Code (as amended) allows the governing body to exercise all administrative powers by resolution including the establishment of water and sewer rates; and

WHEREAS, Section 8.1.3 of the Town's Code requires the rates related to water service, connection fees, penalties and other charges incidental to connection and services from the Town's Water System to be established by the Town Council and set forth in the Laketown Consolidated Fee Schedule; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council previously established a schedule for an annual water rate increase of three percent (3%) to take effect on July 1, 2026; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council desires to provide financial relief to the Town's residents by suspending temporarily the three percent (3%) annual fee for the standard monthly and standard quarterly water service rates for Fiscal Year 2026-2027.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Town Council of Laketown, Utah, as follows:

1. **Suspension Of Annual Rate Increase.** The three percent (3%) annual increase for standard monthly and standard quarterly water services rates scheduled to take effect on July 1, 2026, is hereby suspended temporarily, and shall not be automatically applied for Fiscal Year 2026-2027.
2. **Option To Adjust.** The Town Council may, by subsequent motion or resolution, elect to reinstate, adjust, or collect the three percent (3%) annual water rate increase, or any portion thereof, at any point during the 2026-2027 fiscal period if deemed necessary for the continued operation or maintenance of the Town's Water System.
3. **Effective Date.** This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
