Subject: Shuttle Stop Ordinance

Background

Recently the town planner was directed to draft an ordinance that better defined shuttle stops as a use. This was initiated because of the Zion Corridor Park & Ride service. However, the Planning Commission, in their review, has additional ideas regarding the ordinance and is considering potential amendments. In the meantime, the park and ride shuttle service was implemented under the current code.

More recently, Mayor Kraus has considered that shuttle stops as a use in Commercial and Highway Resort zones may not be necessary at all given that any such future stops would be: 1) publicly or quasi-publicly run; and 2) be located in road rights-of-way (e.g., SR 9). Attached is a recent email from Mayor Kraus further elaborating on her thoughts.

I would like to discuss the concept of removing shuttle stops as a use in Commercial and Highway Resort zones with the Town Council at the April 15, 2026, work meeting. If the consensus is that the use should be removed, it could be referred to the Planning Commission for recommendation.

Recommendation

Staff recommends the Town Council discuss removing shuttle stops as a use in the zoning code and if agreeable, referring the idea to the Planning Commission for a recommendation.
