Wasatch County now has a Comprehensive Emergency Management Plan (CEMP) to support preparedness and response efforts. In this Exercise event, participants will learn:

- How to activate preparedness and response efforts for an emergency event;
- When and who to communicate with during an emergency event; and,
- How to lead decision-making and actions in a realistic, low-stress learning environment.

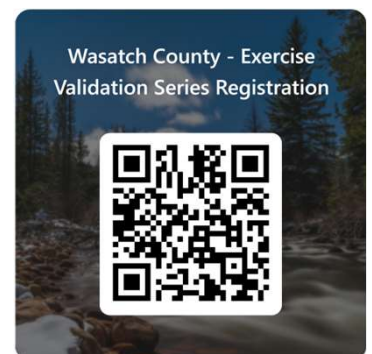
