The Board Meeting of the Goshen Valley Local District (GVLD) was held via Microsoft Teams and in person at the Elberta Valley Ag and Farmland Reserve, Inc. offices.

The meeting was called to order at 1:02 p.m. with Mr. Sheppard conducting the meeting.

1. Welcome (Agenda Item #1 0:07)

Mr. Sheppard welcomed all to the meeting.

2. Roll Call and Statement of Conflict of Interest (Agenda Item #1 & 2 0:09)

- Mr. Sheppard stated that he is the Chairman of the Board. His conflict of interest is that he works for Farmland Reserve, Inc. (FRI), the major landowner within the district boundaries.
- Mr. Munns stated he is a Board Member of GVLD. He is also the Farm Manager at Elberta Valley Ag (EVA) which operates within the district boundaries, a Board Member of Current Creek Irrigation Company which supplies water to EVA, and an alternate Board Member of the Mt Nebo Water Agency
- Mr. Anderson stated that he is a Board Member and Treasurer of GVLD and that he is also the General Manager at EVA.
- Ms. Robinette stated that she is the District Clerk.
- Mr. Sanderson stated he is the District Accountant.
- Mr. Gessel stated he is an attorney and no conflict.
- Mr. Chamberlain stated she is a member of the public and employed by Farmland Reserve and AgReserves.
- Mrs. McVicker stated she is a member of the public and volunteers engineering

services to GVLD.

3. Approval of the November 25, 2025 Pending Minutes (Agenda Item #3 – 3:11)

Mr. Sheppard asked if the Board Members had reviewed the pending minutes from the November meeting. All Board Members stated they had reviewed the pending minutes and there were no changes suggested.

Mr. Anderson moved to approve the minutes from the November 25, 2025, board meeting as presented.

Mr. Munns seconded the motion.

The motion passed unanimously in the affirmative.

4. Financial Report (Agenda Item #5 – 4:25)

Mr. Sanderson presented the financial and budget report, noting the District had completed the fiscal year under budget with minimal outstanding payables. Discussion followed regarding future revenue needs and Mount Nebo Water Agency assessments. Mrs. McVicker discussed anticipated engineering costs for 2026, primarily related to the Impact Fee Plan, and noted infrastructure repair costs would be minimal.

5. Discussion on the GVLD Contract with FRI (Agenda Item #6–11:43)

The Board discussed the proposed water lease agreement with Farmland Reserve, including lease pricing, successors and assigns language, and future water dedication needs tied to development.

Board decided to postpone discussion to April meeting.

6. Review of GVLD Contracts (Agenda Item #7 – 28:04)

Ms. McVicker provided an overview of District contracts and agreements, including water supply, engineering, legal, and groundwater monitoring agreements. Discussion included the value of continued participation in Mount Nebo groundwater monitoring efforts and potential future agenda items.

7. Other Business (Agenda Item #8 – 42:49)

No additional business was presented..

8. Next Meeting (Agenda Item #9)

The next meeting is scheduled for April 9, 2026 at 1:00 pm.

Mr. Sheppard moved to adjourn the meeting. Mr. Andersen seconded the motion.
