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34 Miscellaneous Discussion Items

35 There is a group of local citizens that will be putting together a petition to oppose the proposed
36 Matt Jennings (Bevan Johnson) annexation located at approximately 100 East 500 South. The
37 back half of some of their residential lots are located outside the city limits, and a few of them
38 don't want them annexed. Several citizens have also expressed concern that the city does not
39 have enough water to support residential development in that area.
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41 Councilmember Rausch stated that there is a local landowner who owns property adjacent to the
42 Wildlife Park and he does not want to trade land with the city but would rather provide an
43 easement to the city so that they can develop improvements in that section of the park.

44 Councilmember Winget suggested that the city vacate the roadway on the northwest corner of
45 the park and offer to trade that section of property.
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47 Mayor Hare stated that Stuart Bailey has resigned as planning commission chairperson, and that
48 Melissa Scottorn has filled a voting position on the commission, and that Kim Robison has
49 accepted the position of alternate commissioner.
