7 **SUMMIT COUNTY RESTAURANT TAX GRANT UPDATE**  
8

9 Councilor Darcey updated the council on the progress of the Restaurant Tax Grant  
10 application. Councilor Darcey explained he is working with Jeff Jones with Summit  
11 County. They are now able to track cell phones and determine the number of visitors  
12 there are in Kamas during Fiesta Days. Councilor Darcey may use the information for the  
13 grant interview. There are positive results being reported so we can determine the out of  
14 county visitors during Fiesta Days contributing to our sales tax.

15 Councilor Darcey would like to submit this application tomorrow.

17 Councilor Staples confirmed we are asking for \$125,000 for rodeo and derby prizes. She  
18 asked if we could include the car show since it’s on a different weekend.

19 Councilor Darcey stated yes, we could add them to the car show sponsors and raise the  
20 ask to \$127,500.

38 The vote was unanimous. Councilors Larry Gines, Mike Georgi, Leslie  
39 Staples, David Darcey, and Monica Blazzard voted aye. Motion passed.

42 Mayor McCormick reported the CDBG grant awards are not official. Once it’s officially  
43 announced he will have an update.

44 Councilor Gines asked Mayor McCormick if he had talked to Spencer with MAG  
45 regarding the salary study.

1 Mayor McCormick stated yes, he replied he will be putting it together for us in a couple  
2 of weeks once he completes another project.
