ORDINANCE NO. 26-04

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF TAYLORSVILLE AMENDING
TAYLORSVILLE MUNICIPAL CODE TITLE 17.02: FLOOD DAMAGE
REGULATIONS**

WHEREAS, the Taylorsville City Council (the “Council”) met in regular session on April 15, 2026, to discuss, among other things, updating Title 17.02 Flood Damage Prevention Regulations; and

WHEREAS, The Utah State Legislature has delegated the responsibility to local governments to adopt regulations designed to minimize flood losses.; and

WHEREAS, the City of Taylorsville maintains flood damage prevention regulations to promote the public health, safety, and general welfare and to minimize public and private losses due to flood conditions in specific areas, consistent with the National Flood Insurance Program and applicable federal and state requirements; and

WHEREAS, the existing regulations in Title 17.02 were last substantially amended by Ordinance No. 21-01 on January 6, 2021, and the City has determined that targeted updates are necessary to reflect current best practices, clarify certain provisions, ensure continued compliance with FEMA standards, and address minor administrative and technical revisions; and

WHEREAS, the proposed amendments to Title 17.02 are set forth in the document titled “Title 17.02 Flood Damage Prevention Regulations” a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit “A” and incorporated herein by this reference; and

WHEREAS, the effective management and updating of flood damage prevention regulations is essential for protecting life, property, and the community’s tax base while maintaining eligibility for federal flood insurance; and

WHEREAS, after due consideration and public input, the Council has determined that it is in the best interest of the general health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Taylorsville to approve the proposed amendments to Title 17.02.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Taylorsville City Council that the proposed amendments to Title 17.02 Flood Damage Prevention Regulations of the Taylorsville City Code, as set forth in Exhibit “A” attached hereto, are hereby approved.

This Ordinance, assigned Ordinance No. 26-04, shall take effect upon passage and approval.


