Public Budget Hearing & Regular Meeting Minutes

Date: December 3, 2025

Time: Meeting commenced at approx. 6:00 PM

Location: Hinckley Lions Building – Hinckley, Utah

1. Call to Order

- **Pledge of Allegiance:** Led by the group.
- **Roll Call:** Mike Anderson (Chair), Daryl Dutson, Skip Taylor, Mark Talbot, Diane Greener, and Deb Wagner (Secretary).
- **Visitors:** Allen Miller.

2. Public Hearing: 2026 Budget Adoption

- **Opening:** A motion to open the public hearing for the 2026 budget was made by Daryl Dutson and seconded by Skip Taylor.
- **Budget Overview:**
 - **Proposed Budget:** \$43,290.
 - **Income Sources:** Millard County taxes (\$25,993), plot sales (\$4,000), interest (\$300), and other income (\$200) for a total of \$30,493.
 - **Funding Gap:** The \$13,200 deficit will be covered by PTIF funds (\$11,800) and remaining 2025 checking account balances (\$9,800).
- **Annexation Update:** Commissioner Johnson requested pushing the Deseret building project to late 2026 to align with the pending annexation into the Delta Sutherland Oasis District, expected between Q1 and June 2026 .
- **Key Expense Details:**
 - **Wages:** Hinckley Sexton wages will be absorbed by Delta Sutherland Oasis; Deseret wages budgeted at \$6,900.
 - **Maintenance:** No fertilizer costs were added as Delta Sutherland Oasis will cover these. Repairs are budgeted at \$10,000 (\$4k Hinckley / \$6k Deseret).
- **Resolution 251203:** Motion to accept the 2026 budget as printed was made by Skip Taylor and seconded by Daryl Dutson. **Motion passed via roll call vote .**
- **Closing:** Motion to close the public hearing by Diane Greener, seconded by Skip Taylor.

3. Review of Previous Minutes

- **October 1, 2025 Minutes:** Approved without changes (Motion: Skip Taylor; Second: Daryl Dutson).
- **November 10, 2025 Truth & Taxation Minutes:** Approved (Motion: Diane Greener; Second: Skip Taylor).

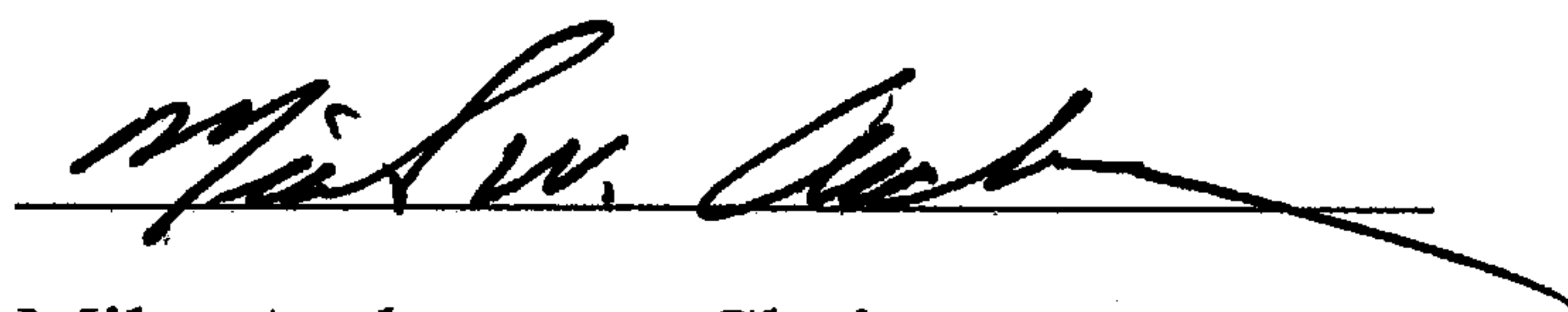
4. District Business & Maintenance

- **Plot Transfers (Wilkins Family):** Deb Wagner reported a request to transfer plots in Block 4. There is a discrepancy in the map regarding usable graves. Skip Taylor will probe the area to verify availability.
- **Sexton/Caretaker Resignations & Transition:**

- Daryl Dutson will step off the board to avoid a conflict of interest as he prepares to bid for cemetery digging services.
- Deb Wagner expressed a willingness to stay through the annexation but noted she may leave if the process is delayed until the very end of the year.
- **Deseret Cemetery Repairs:**
 - **Irrigation:** Discussion regarding a major leak at Deseret that caused a \$449 monthly water bill. Repairs to the valves and wiring are planned for spring.
 - **Sprinkler Management:** Skip Taylor noted that improper hose watering has created "duck ponds" and suggested using rotating heads.

5. Adjournment

- **Tax Levy Update:** The tax levy was increased from .000174 to .000241 to minimize disparity with the Delta district upon annexation.
 - **Motion to Adjourn:** Made by Skip Taylor, seconded by Daryl Dutson. Meeting adjourned at approx. 6:45 PM.
