Public Hearing – Street Improvement Revenue Bonds

The public hearing was opened at 6:30 p.m. to receive input regarding the proposed issuance of Street Improvement Revenue Bonds in an amount not to exceed \$1,750,000 for the purpose of financing street and drainage improvements, together with all related work.

Notice of the public hearing was duly published in accordance with the Utah Local Government Bonding Act.

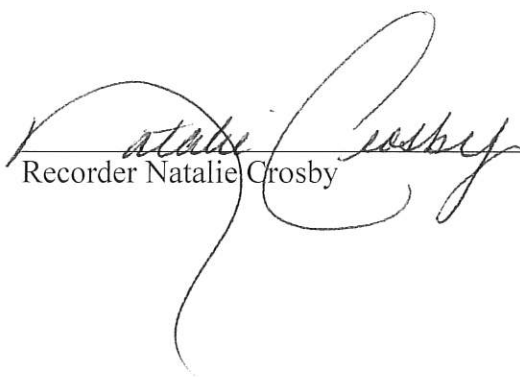
Sunrise Engineering presented a map identifying the areas proposed for improvement. It was also noted that the Community Impact Board (CIB) has approved grant funding for Mt. Pleasant City related to the project.

Colter Allen stated that the City has made significant efforts to maintain and improve its road infrastructure.

Rondy Black noted that Mt. Pleasant City maintains approximately 38 miles of paved roads, which is among the highest in the county.
