1. Orem's birthday

A. May 6th Celebration Options (Handout)

- a. Farmers Market - First Farmers Market of the Year - Expecting 6,000 attendees

2. May 9th Service Project Options (Handout)

- A. After discussion of several service opportunities, Nielson's Grove Park was selected as the service project. This is a "large flower planting project" scheduled from 9:00 am - 12:00 pm.

Action Item: Bradley will arrange for the service project information to be distributed to the schools so it can be included in their digital newsletters.

3. America 250 announcements

- A. Currently displayed in Library Hall, "The Pen is Mightier". This display has different items communicating life, liberty and the pursuit of happiness. It opened in February and is running until May 10th. Open during regular library hours.
- B. Liberty Tree in Orem City Center Park is lit nightly in red, white and blue. The Liberty Tree will light up every evening until July 4th.
- C. Patriotic concert "Let Freedom Ring" with Timpanogos Chorale, Thursday, April 30th @ 7:00 pm, Library Hall.

6. Beautification Awards:

- A. Review plans from March 11, 2026 meeting (HANDOUT)
 - a. Nomination period May 10th - June 30th, 2026
 - b. After discussion, the committee felt 10 signs per district was too many and dropped the amount of signs to 5 per district.
 - c. Citizens will have the opportunity to nominate their neighbors or self-nominate through official City channels
 - d. Commission members will be provided a way to access or receive the nominations particular to their neighborhood.
 - e. Commission members ultimately determine which homes will receive a yard sign.
 - f. Commission members are encouraged to invite their friends and neighbors to submit nominations.
 - g. Signs will be distributed to commission members at the meeting on May 13th

- B. Determine next steps

- a. City Staff will prepare and distribute the nominations via email the week of July 1 - July 8 for voting by commission members.
- b. Voting results will be reviewed during the July 8th meeting.
- c. Each district will have one winner per district with one overall winner being selected
- d. Awards for each winner will be ordered and distributed to the recipients mid-July

Action Item: The City will create a way for citizen nominations to be received.

Action Item: The City will advertise through its social media channels the Beautification awards and the ability to nominate their neighbors or self-nominate.

Action Item: The City will train commission members on how to access the nominations for their district or provide the nominations to district leaders for review.

7. Community gardens (Handout)

- A. Grow boxes on the North side of the Library

Action Item: Bradley will check with Bryce Merrill on the plans for this area. Bradley will then update the commission on his findings.
