ORDINANCE 2026-08**

TITLE 1 – GENERAL PROVISIONS

AN ORDINANCE OF MARRIOTT-SLATERVILLE CITY, UTAH, REPEALING AND RE-ENACTING TITLE 1 ENTITLED “GENERAL PROVISIONS” AS PART OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE; RENUMBERING CHAPTER 01.20 ENTITLED CONSTITUTIONAL TAKINGS TO CHAPTER 03.40; SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Marriott-Slaterville City (hereafter “City”) is a municipal corporation, duly organized and existing under the laws of the State of Utah;

WHEREAS, Marriott-Slaterville City functions under the optional form of government known as the council-mayor form of government as provided in *Utah Code Annotated* §§ 10-3-1219;

WHEREAS, *Utah Code Annotated* §10-8-84 and §10-8-60 allow municipalities in the State of Utah to exercise certain police powers and nuisance abatement powers, including but not limited to providing for safety and preservation of health, promotion of prosperity, improve community well-being, peace and good order for the inhabitants of the City;

WHEREAS, the City desires to repeal and re-enact an updated Title 1 of the *Marriott-Slaterville Municipal Code*;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the City Council of Marriott-Slaterville as follows:

Section 1. Repealer. Any ordinance or portion of the municipal code inconsistent with this Ordinance is hereby repealed and any reference thereto is hereby vacated.

Section 2. Re-enactment. Title 1 of the *Marriott-Slaterville Municipal Code* is hereby repealed and re-enacted to read as follows:

In accordance with Utah Code §10-3-707, as amended, all current ordinances of a general nature adopted by the City Council of Marriott-Slaterville City, Utah, as revised, compiled, and set forth in this book entitled the “*Marriott-Slaterville Municipal Code*” (“Municipal Code” or “MSMC”) are hereby published and declared to be the Municipal Code.

01.01.020 Codification and Corrections.

1. Delegation. In accordance with Utah Code §10-3-707, as amended, and in order to facilitate effective application of ordinances adopted by the City Council, administrative staff is hereby delegated authority to compile or arrange for the compilation of all applicable ordinances of a general nature into the Municipal Code.
2. Authority. Administrative staff is hereby granted continuing authority including but not limited to the follows:
 - a. Administer the Municipal Code and carry out the provisions authorized in Utah Code §10-3-707, -708, -709, -710, and -711 to create, compile, revise and enforce the Municipal Code.
 - b. Create, modify, and update titles, chapters, sections, names and headings, summaries, and/or other parts of the Municipal Code.
 - c. Codify relevant existing ordinances into the Municipal Code.
 - d. Codify any and all relevant subsequent ordinances in the Municipal Code.
 - e. Make non-substantive corrections, technical changes, modifications, additions, and substitutions as administrative staff deems is best to develop a complete and simplified Municipal Code free of inconsistencies.
 - f. Publish the Municipal Code and make it available for the public.
 - g. Otherwise execute and implement the Municipal Code.

01.01.030 Format.

This Municipal Code is formatted and is organized by subject matter under an expandable three-factor decimal numbering system which is designed to facilitate supplementation without disturbing the numbering of existing provisions. Each section number designates, in sequence, the numbers of the appropriate Title, Chapter and Section. Thus, section 12.13.050 is section .050, located in Chapter 13 of Title 12. In most instances, Sections are numbered by tens (.010., .020., 030., and so forth) which leaves nine (9) vacant positions between original Sections to accommodate future provisions. Similarly, Chapters and Titles are numbered to provide for internal expansion. Also, some Sections simply have a number and a heading to provide convenient accommodations for future expansion. Subsections are also added based upon a decimal system. For example, the appropriate Subsection format under this decimal system would be Subsection 12.13.050.1.a.ii.

01.01.040 General Severability.

Unless an ordinance specifically states otherwise, any declaration by any court of competent jurisdiction, or other legitimate binding legal source, that any provision of the Municipal Code is illegal or void, shall not effect the legality and enforcement of any other provision of the Municipal Code.

01.03.010 General Definitions.

In the construction of and throughout the Municipal Code, based upon ordinances adopted by the City Council, the following definitions govern, unless such definitions would be inconsistent with the manifest intent of the City Council or repugnant to the context of the specific ordinance. General statutory rules of construction apply to this Municipal Code. Gender neutral terms shall be used in this Municipal Code. Any reference in the Municipal Code to an agency, branch, department, division, or similar term that is not in existence shall simply mean the City, or its provider, as the context dictates.

1. “Health Department” or similar term means the Weber-Morgan Health Department, unless assigned to another agency.
2. “Business” means any activity, operation, enterprise or calling referred to in this code for which a license is required.
3. “City” or similar term means Marriott-Slaterville City, its corporate limits, and its providers as the context dictates.
4. “City Council” means the City Council of the City.
5. “City Administrator” mean the department head or director of the Administrative Services Department.
6. “City Attorney” means the City Attorney of the City, any deputy, or contract providers as the context dictates.
7. “City Engineer” or similar term means the City Engineer, any deputy, or contract providers as the context dictates.
8. “City Recorder” or similar term means the City Recorder, designee of the City Administrator, or any deputy as the context dictates.
9. “City Treasurer” or similar term means the City Treasurer of the City.
10. “Culinary Water District” or similar term means the culinary water district or provider as the context dictates.
11. “Department” means a department created by the City.
12. “Director” means the head of a department created by the City.
13. “Fire District” or similar term means the Weber County Fire District, local fire authority, or other provider as the context dictates.

14. “Knowingly” or similar term imports only a knowledge that facts exist that bring the act or omission within the provisions of this Municipal Code. It does not require any knowledge of the unlawfulness of such act or omission.
15. “Law” means and denotes the governing constitution, applicable federal law, applicable law of the State of Utah, this Municipal Code, and policies, regulations, rules, and standards of the City.
16. “Maliciously” or similar term means and imports a wish to vex, annoy, or injure another person, or an intent to do a wrongful act, established either by proof or by presumption of law.
17. “Occupant” means any person or entity who occupies the whole or any part of such building or land either individually or with others.
18. “Official” or similar term means a person or entity who is an agent, appointee, contractor, elected officer, employee, provider, volunteer, or other officially tasked with carrying out a municipal duty or service of the City as the context dictates.
19. “Owner” or similar term where applied to a building, business, corporation, entity, or property means and includes the owner, any part owner, joint owner, tenant in common, joint tenant, and/or tenant.
20. “Person” or similar term includes any association, corporation, entity, individual, partnership, or group of individuals, however organized or designated.
21. “Property” means and includes real property, tenements, and hereditaments. It also means personal property including but not limited to chattel, goods, money, and transactional actions such as securities and debt.
22. “Sewer District” or similar term means the Weber Central Sewer Improvement District, its contract providers, or other applicable entity as the context dictates.
23. “Sheriff” or similar term means the Weber County Sheriff, sheriff deputy, law enforcement authority, or provider as the context dictates.
24. “State” means the state of Utah.
25. “Willfully” or similar term when applied to the intent with which an act is done or omitted, means and implies simply a purpose or willingness to commit the act or make the omission referred to. It does not require any intent to violate law or to injure another or to acquire any advantage.
26. “Written” means and includes electronic, printed, typed or otherwise reproduced in permanent visible form.
27. “Year” means a calendar year unless otherwise specified.

01.03.020 Violations and Penalties.

The Executive Branch of the City shall enforce the Municipal Code and any governing Law. Administrative staff is hereby delegated authority to create a bail schedule and/or fine schedule based upon the ordinances compiled as part of this Municipal Code. Where no penalty is prescribed in the Municipal Code, the penalty assigned shall not exceed the highest penalty provided by Law for the offense as administered by the City. Typically, this means the City can only prosecute or seek a criminal penalty not to exceed a class “B” misdemeanor, unless otherwise provided by Law. Each day a violation continues is a separate offense. Where no civil

penalty is prescribed in the Municipal Code, the penalty assigned will not exceed a civil fine of \$1,000, unless otherwise provided by Law. No violation or penalty applies to the City or any of its officials acting in the course of their duties.

01.03.030 Code Availability.

This Municipal Code is only published online and made available to the public via the City’s website, or other online services, unless otherwise required by Law.

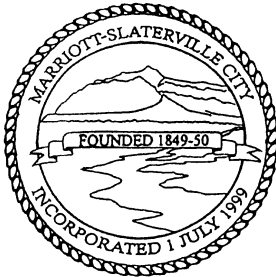

01.05.010 City Seal.

1. Seal. The following Seal is hereby established and declared to be the Official Seal of Marriott-Slaterville City which may be in black and white or in full color, as may be appropriate form of use under the circumstances:



2. Features. The Official Seal of Marriott-Slaterville City features:
 - a. A circle with a rope-type design around the outside.
 - b. Ben Lomond Peak in the top half of the circle.
 - c. An open plain with Mill Creek in the bottom half of the circle depicting this stream that traverses between the historical pioneer settlements of Marriott and Slaterville.
 - d. The date of founding of the community as 1849-1850.
 - e. The name "Marriott-Slaterville City" rounding the top.
 - f. The date of incorporation as July 1, 1999, rounding the bottom.
3. Custodian. The City Recorder serves as custodian and keeper of the Official Seal of Marriott-Slaterville City. The Official City Seal of Marriott-Slaterville City may be in the form of a embosser stamp, ink stamp, print, electronic, or other medium. The Official Seal of Marriott-Slaterville City may be affixed by any Officer in the course of their duties to official City documents as authorized, needed, and practical.

01.05.020 City Logo.

1. The following Logo is hereby established and declared to be the Official Logo of Marriott-Slaterville City which may be in black and white or in full color, as may be appropriate form of use under the circumstances:
 - a. Standard. Use of this Standard Logo is preferred:



- b. Simplified. In the event that the Standard Logo is not feasible or under other circumstances this Simplified Logo is acceptable:



2. Features. The Official Logo of Marriott-Slaterville City features:
 - a. Four (4) colors representing the earth, seasons, sky, and water arranged in an alternating flowing pattern to resemble a watercourse, with colors in the following order:
 - i. Light blue at the top representing the sky and also winter.
 - ii. Blended orange representing summer and fall for the harvest seasons.
 - iii. Blue representing the irrigation and water the is the life of our community.
 - iv. Green at the bottom representing the earth and spring.
 - b. “Marriott-Slaterville” in a block font along the top with “City” featured in a larger cursive font.
 - c. Accents of birds/vegetation representing the farming, ruralness, wetlands, and wildlife heritage of the community.
3. Use. The Official Logo of Marriott-Slaterville City may be affixed by any Officer in the course of their duties to official City documents as authorized, needed, and practical.

01.05.030 City Flag.

The Official Flag of Marriott-Slaterville City is the Standard Logo with or without “Marriott-Slaterville City” and the “accents” included.

Section 3. Renumbered. Chapter 01.20 entitled “Constitutional Takings” is hereby renumbered to Chapter 3.40.

Section 4. Severability. If a court of competent jurisdiction determines that any part of this Ordinance is unconstitutional or invalid, then such portion of this Ordinance, or specific application of this Ordinance, shall be severed from the remainder, which shall continue in full force and effect.

Section 5. Effective date. This Ordinance take effect immediately upon mayoral approval and posting.
