1. **Mayor Woolstenhulme** opened the meeting.
2. Invocation: **Mayor Zane Woolstenhulme**

**3. PUBLIC COMMENT:**

**Mayor Woolstenhulme** asked **Recorder Rydalch** to briefly address an item on the consent calendar.

**Recorder Rydalch** addressed the Old Dominion Race proposal explaining that the City has been reached out to by a party from Virginia that has ties to this area that would like to organize a foot race in the

42 Oakley/Kamas area. The series of races is considered a clamshell as they host a variety of distances,  
43 including a marathon, half marathon, 10k, 4k and a kids fun run. The racing proposal utilizes portions of  
44 Oakley City roads in concert with state and county roadways. They would also like to use the Oakley  
45 Recreation complex for their start and finish line production. The areas in Oakley most impacted by the  
46 races is the Millrace area as well as Weber Canyon. She then displayed the map of the different race  
47 maps. Staff is recommending that if Council is amenable to the race series that they approve tonight for  
48 staff to enter into an agreement that is contingent upon approval from UDOT, Summit County and the  
49 various public safety departments, and furnishing the City with a certificate of insurance for their event,  
50 indemnifying the City. thanked him for his comment and stated that it would be placed in the record.  
51 But the council will not be addressing these concerns tonight. He will be discussing related items during  
52 his Mayor Report later in the meeting.

59 **Councilmember Smart** motioned to approve the Consent Calendar. **Councilmember Neff** seconded the  
60 motion. All voted in favor. **Consent Calendar Approved.**

62 **5. GENERAL BUSINESS**

63 **5.1 2026 Rodeo Ticketing Policy: Recorder Rydalch** presented Council with staff recommendation  
64 for the 2026 rodeo ticket sales. She stated that several options were considered, i.e., redefining  
65 locals only to include zip code areas, in person vs. online sales, ticket limitations and time frames  
66 for purchase. After much consideration staff proposed one day of local-only pre-sale, in-person  
67 ticket sales, and online general public sales with a ticket limitation of 25 tickets total.

69 **Councilmember Wilmoth** suggested increasing the ticket limitation for online sales from 25 to 35  
70 tickets.

71

72 Discussion amongst councilmembers is that it is impossible to make everyone happy.

73

74 **Councilmember Wilmoth** moved to approve the 2026 Rodeo Ticketing Policy as presented with a change  
75 to ticket limitation for online sales to be 35 tickets. **Councilmember Frazier** seconded the motion. **All**  
76 **voted in favor. Policy approved.**

78 **6. CANVASS OF THE 2025 OAKLEY MUNICIPAL ELECTION**

79 **Recorder Rydalch** presented the election canvas report to the City Council/Board of Canvassers.  
80 The report detailed the turnout and vote totals for the Oakley City Mayoral and City Council  
81 races. She explained the process for handling provisional ballots and their qualification.
