School Events

Fee Hearing, Second Consideration of Fee Schedule, School Year 2026-27

The Administration has provided a recommended fee schedule for school year 2026-27. As part of the legally required process for adoption of a fee schedule and spend plan, the Board of Directors must also consider the schedule in a second hearing in a public meeting in order to provide stakeholders with a chance to comment and give feedback. The Administration recommends discussion of the fee schedule for the 2026-27 school year with approval to be determined in the board's April 2026 meeting.

Policy Review

Admissions and Enrollment Policy (Revised)

The Admissions and Enrollment Policy has a new section, "Records or Record Review Required for Enrollment," which is required by Utah Code §53G-6-403 as a result of a law passed in the 2026 Utah Legislative Session. Please see the added section below called "Records or Record Review Required for Enrollment."

- **"Records or Record Review Required for Enrollment"**
Per Utah Code §53G-6-403, the school may not enroll a student unless the student record from the previous school has been received or the school administrator or designee reviews the data gateway for any safe-school violation, reintegration, or threat assessment related to an enrolling student.

Student Acceleration and Retention Policy (Revised)

This policy has been revised to give more information about the evaluation criteria related to requests for retention or acceleration; provisions related to students receiving specialized instruction or EL students, and more information on the process of appeal. The policy has been checked to ensure that state law and board rule have been referenced throughout and that the links are still live.

Safe Schools, Discipline, and Behavior Policy (Revised)

This policy has been revised in the following ways:

- The Emergency Safety Interventions sections of the policy have been removed in light of the new stand-alone board policy governing Emergency Safety Interventions.
- The definition of "expulsion" has been updated to reflect updated USBE Admin. Rule: Expulsion: as defined in Utah Admin. Rule R277-609, a disciplinary removal from school for more than ten school days without an offer of alternative educational service. While this removal is defined as exceeding 10 days, it may function as a permanent removal or long-term exclusion from school. Although an expulsion may be recommended by administration, it must be imposed by a school board or a designated board committee. Parents of expelled students are

responsible to comply with compulsory education laws of the State of Utah by providing other educational services for the student and paying all associated costs thereof.
