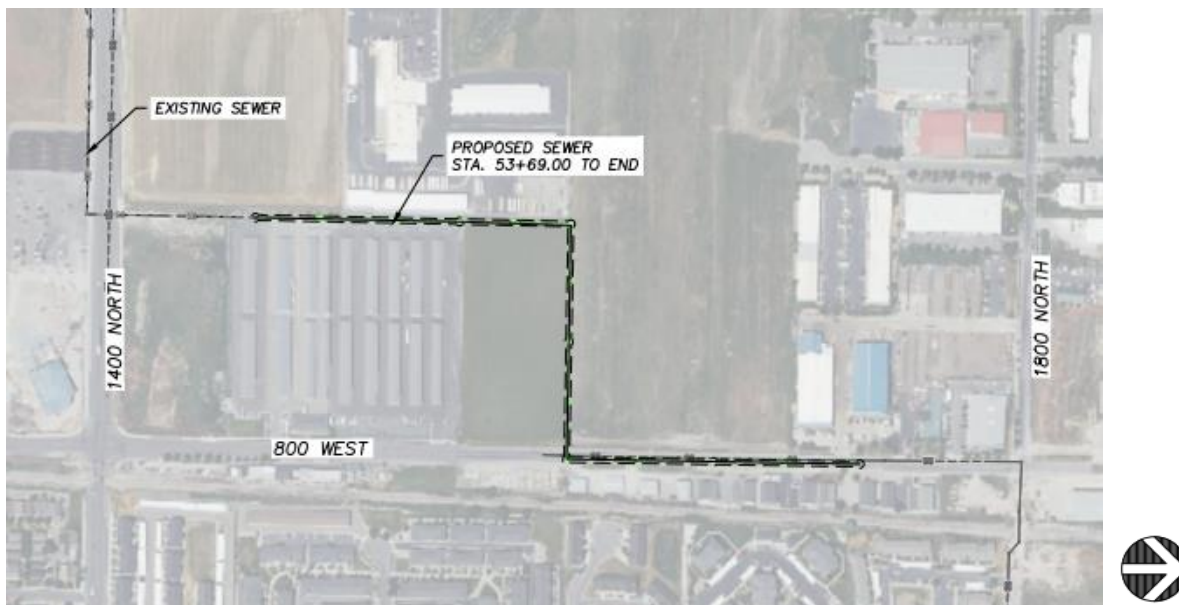
Subject: Request for Environmental Review Comments - North Logan City Sewer Extension (SRF Project)

To Whom It May Concern,

This letter is being provided as part of the Utah Division of Water Quality (DWQ) State Revolving Fund (SRF) cross-cutter agency notification requirements. North Logan City is proposing to construct a portion of the North Logan City Sewer Trunk Line to ensure adequate wastewater capacity for existing and future development. Based on environmental review, the project is not expected to result in significant environmental impacts.

Project Overview

The project is located between North Logan and Logan City from approximately 1400 N to 1800 N and between 800 W and 1000 W. See the vicinity map below:



Construction will occur within existing public road right of way, utility easements, and previously farmed agricultural land. All disturbed areas will be restored after construction is completed. North Logan City evaluated several alternatives. The selected alternative and alignment minimize environmental impacts.

Although surface activities have occurred previously, the subsurface soils at the proposed excavation depths are undisturbed. Work will involve trenching, pipeline installation, backfilling, and restoration within defined limits.

Endangered Species Review

A U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service database review identified three species within Cache County: Ute Ladies'-tresses orchid (threatened), Monarch Butterfly (proposed threatened), and Suckley's Cuckoo Bumble Bee (proposed endangered). No critical habitat for these species exists within the project area, and the agricultural and roadway land uses do not provide suitable habitat. The project will have no effect on these species or their habitats.

Cultural and Historic Preservation

No known cultural or historic resources are located within the project corridor. While soil conditions make preservation unlikely, excavation below previously disturbed depths present a possibility of encountering unknown artifacts. If any cultural materials or human remains are discovered during construction, work will stop immediately, and the Utah State Historic Preservation Office will be notified for consultation and direction.

Additional Environmental Findings

- No federally designated wetlands occur within the project limits.
- No FEMA floodplains are present.
- No tree removal is required.
- No prime farmland will be converted or impacted.

Based on the environmental analysis, the proposed project is expected to have no significant impact on the human environment. A FONSI is anticipated pending agency review.

As part of the environmental review, we request your review and comment regarding any potential environmental concerns or requirements under your agency's jurisdiction. Please provide responses within 30 days. Let us know if additional information or coordination is needed.
