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Call to Order

The meeting was called to order by Chair Wendy Moss at 4:00 PM.

Approval of Previous Meeting Minutes

The minutes from the previous meeting were reviewed.

A motion to approve the previous meeting minutes was made by Cyndee Burnham and seconded by Stacey Hane.

The motion passed unanimously.

Presentation – Trust Lands Plan

Chair Wendy Moss introduced Jeff Greiner, who presented the final draft of the Trust Lands Plan for 2027.

Mr. Greiner highlighted that the primary goal of the plan is to ensure adequate para-educator coverage in all classrooms in order to reduce student screen time. He also explained the reasoning behind the data measurements used to gauge success and the importance of targeting and measuring meaningful progress for all students.

Chair Wendy Moss asked if the committee had any further questions or needed additional clarification. There were no further questions.

Approval of Trust Lands Plan

Chair Wendy Moss called for a motion to approve the Trust Lands Plan as presented.

A motion was made by Cyndee Burnham and seconded by Jeff Greiner.

The Trust Lands Plan for 2027 was approved unanimously.

TSSA Funding Update

Jeff Greiner provided an overview of the Trust Lands Student Success Allocation (TSSA) funding. He explained that, due to the school's size, Silver Summit Elementary qualifies for this funding, which is significant and requires the school to set specific improvement goals.

This year's TSSA allocation is \$14,300 and will be used as follows:

- \$11,000 will support para-educator salaries to provide additional classroom coverage and reduce student screen time.
- \$3,320 will compensate Cyndee Burnham for her work as DIBELS and Acadience Math administrator. This includes proper student data entry, testing schedules, and submitting all required reports to the state to maintain compliance and strong school performance. This role ensures that the school meets all state reporting requirements set by the legislature for Utah public schools.

Chair Wendy Moss asked if the committee had any further questions or needed additional clarification. There were no further questions.
