#3 Items for Discussion or Update

a. Review Previous Plan for Opioid Settlement Funds

Mathis presented on what to do with the opioid settlement funds was presented. The original group that met regarding these funds suggested that 70% of the funds be used for treatment and 30% for prevention with an emphasis on case management and warm hand offs for individuals leaving jail.

Council discussed how to use the receiving center when it opens, possible case management housed within the justice court, making sure families are involved and have access to case workers also, and helping those incarcerated to receive Medicaid in jail to help with cost of treatment.

Council discussed the Justice Court system and all the changes that have happened in the past couple of years and some of the changes coming in the future.

b. Update on Expand Eligibility Specialist for Jail Transition Support

Cook, Mathis, Lambert, and Jensen will work on case management, such as how many case managers, where they should be housed, and how to use them the most effectively.
