1. Possible Tax Reduction

In regards to the one-time solar tax funding through the Community Reinvestment Agencies (CRA), the 2026 tax levies were discussed; specifically the Debt Levy which could be lowered by the additional funds collected through the solar project CRAs.

This would allow the District to lower the taxes collected by \$400,000. Future discussion with county officials will be held to analyze other possible options in an effort to lower residential property taxes.
