Qualification to Vote

U.S. Citizen, resident of the State of Utah for over 30 days preceding the election, 18 years of age by November 5, 2026. To register to vote or to update information, visit vote.utah.gov.

Certification of Ballot Counting Equipment

Duchesne County will publicly conduct a logic and accuracy test of the tabulating equipment that will be used to count the ballots for the Primary Election on **June 3 at 10:00 AM**. The test will be conducted in the Duchesne County Administration Building, Conference Room #1. The test is open to the public in accordance with Utah Code 20A-4-104 and 20A-3-201

Ballots will be mailed out around June 2nd, 2026.
